Why in News?

Prime Minister will attend the [Annual DGP-IGP Conference](#) at the **Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Nava Raipur, Chhattisgarh**, a high-level national meeting focused on policing, security coordination, and law-enforcement reforms.

- This year's conference theme is **"Viksit Bharat: Security Dimensions"**, focusing on creating a forward-looking roadmap for a ['Surakshit Bharat'](#).

Key Points

- The **DGP-IGP Conference** is an **annual national-level meeting organised by the [Intelligence Bureau \(IB\)](#)**, functioning under the [Union Ministry of Home Affairs \(MHA\)](#).
- It brings together **Directors General (DGs) and Inspectors General (IGs)** from all **States and Union Territories** making it the **highest-level platform for [internal security deliberations](#)** in India.
- Major participants include national security bodies involved include: [Research and Analysis Wing \(RAW\)](#), [National Investigation Agency \(NIA\)](#), [National Technical Research Organisation \(NTRO\)](#), [Narcotics Control Bureau \(NCB\)](#), and [Central Armed Police Forces \(CAPFs\)](#) such as **CRPF, BSF, ITBP, CISF, and SSB**.
- Key areas of discussion include:
 - [Left-Wing Extremism \(Naxalism\)](#) and remaining hotspots
 - [Counter-terrorism frameworks](#) and intelligence coordination
 - [Drug trafficking networks](#) and inter-agency cooperation
 - [Cyber security](#), digital forensics, and emerging tech threats
 - [Border management](#), especially on sensitive fronts
 - [Operational synergy](#) between Central and State police forces
- Special emphasis this year is on [AI-driven predictive policing](#), [women safety](#), [crime data integration platforms](#), and [modernisation of police infrastructure](#), ensuring a tech-enabled, future-ready policing system.
