STEP 1: PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT OF JOINEE

1. Two Performance Assessment Tests in first two weeks

The purpose of conducting the tests is SWOT analysis of each Mentee's initial preparation level.

STEP 2: DETAILED PLAN OF ACTION

- 1. Subject-wise plan (85 Days)
 - Day-wise plan for each subject including Quick Revision Classes,
 Tests and Handouts
- 2. Sectional & Revision Tests
 - 50 Questions every third day for GS (every 4th/5th day for CSAT)
 - 100 Questions at the end of each segment (80 Questions for CSAT)
 - Regular Test Discussions & Doubt Clearing Sessions
- 3. Performance Tracker

Test-wise and cumulative analysis based on-

- Accuracy rate (correct/incorrect)
- Subject wise comparative command.
- Tests attempted so far & the percentage of syllabus covered.
- Attendance.
- Comparative analysis of performance with other students in terms of marks & rank.
- Post-test feedback form for self evaluation.

STEP 3: MENTORING SESSIONS

- 1. One-to-one sessions with the mentor
 - Session with Mentor after tests for course correction.
- 2. Group Sessions
 - A peer group to interact and learn about various UPSC dynamics.
- 3. Expert Sessions
 - Sessions with faculties, selected candidates, academic experts.
