Topic:

Good Judgement comes from experience and Experiences come from bad judgement

'Sapiens: struggle of humankind'
a book by Yuval Noah Harari, a famous historian is now a trending topic of discussion among scholars. He illustrated struggle of early human being for their survival and adaptive strategic in unhabitable environment. He mentions about fierce competition among primitive men for resource grab due to scarcity and limited quantity even to extent of practising Cannibalism, eating their fellow members to satisfy



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their own needs. This self centered attitude and judgement of people does not bode well resulting in thinning of their own population making them more vulnerable to attack from bigger carnivores. This realisation made them to shift their strategies and embark on collective hunting. With coordination and efforts of multiple men instead of single hunt. This not only ensured better catch of wild animals but also strengthened bond and cohesion among them.

Noah Harari highlights that this good judgment of collective hunting and cooperation came from experienced gained under earlier bad decisions centred around self interest and rivalry. Thus this example illustrates that very often our good decisions

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Come from long history of bad decisions and experiences gained from it. In this essay we will delve into much deeper aspect like how good decisions are based on earlier long tapestry of bad decisions, does it always lead to good judgment after bad one and if yes, then how come so.

History is replete with many examples which shows good judgement does not come easily. It is battle of churning between ~~synthesis~~ ~~antisynthesis~~ thesis and antithesis resulting better synthesis at last for example the landmark judgement by Supreme Court in 2018 'Navtej Singh Johar Case' which is considered harbinger of rights of LGBTQ community in India.

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Come after series of judgements like No2 foundation case, 2009, Suresh Kumar Case 2013. Earlier judgements were based on parochial nature, and non-inclusive nature. But such bad judgement in past led to more injustice and discrimination to vulnerable people in country forcing judiciary to reverse its earlier judgment and give new verdict. This exemplifies how judiciary and societies learnt from bad experience and followed thereafter path toward good judgement.

Another example can be illustrated in environmental governance in world. In 1980s - and 1990s there was urgency shown by all over world to take actions against climate change and mitigate its impact. The global efforts resulted fruitfully into conception of 'Kyoto protocol' in 1997.

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Under UNFCCC where each country was given a rigid target to achieve. This strict, non flexible, coercive approach could not bring much positive impact resulting into bad experience in global governance. Thereafter a new approach in 'Paris deal' in 2016 focusing on Intentionally national determined contribution (INDC) which acknowledged the differential abilities and capacities of individual nations in mitigation and adaptation efforts. So it exhorted the voluntary individual contribution that has been able to show some positive changes in climate change governance world learnt from past history and traversed towards new approach.

Moreover the example of Wright brother in human tapestry shows

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long history of multiple bad decisions and failure experiences. that ultimately resulted in innovation of airplane. It is the failures that unleashed their potential and build their strong character finally resulting a single good judgement and fulfilling dream of human flight in sky.

Above all examples illustrates how bad ~~examples~~ ^{judgements} have resulted in fruitful good judgements in future by gaining experience in it. Bad judgement taken earlier broadens our horizon and makes us think differently with innovation approach that might work. Bad experiences makes us humble and reminds us that there is a long way for our improvement we must strive harder for it. It gives us ideas of what things works

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and what not in taking us toward our goal. This learning eventually results in future good decision that's why we say that we learn a lot from history.

However it is not always that bad judgement in past will result good judgement thereafter. We have witnessed devastating impacts of world war I. These bad decision of violence alliances, territorial expansions does not deter us from world war II.

Ironically, this was more adverseful than earlier war. Not stopping here we are heading toward a new global war with Russia-ukrain, Israel-Hama war acting as flash points.

So it means we have not learnt from our past bad judgement and still

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heading toward global destruction, violence, and bloodshed.

One thing we must understand that it is learning from bad experiences and judgements when applied wisely in present will help in taking good judgement. Otherwise one will be stuck in cycle of vicious bad decisions. One should modify his/her strategy, approach, thinking perspective from inputs got from earlier bad judgements and their implications.

Sometimes bad judgement in past can influence your present judgement in negative way by instilling fear of failure, making you risk averse and confused while taking judgement in future. History might entangle individual with present

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experiences. A child who has experienced bad experiences in past tend to be more emotionally sensitive and cautious in adult life affecting his/her free decision making ability. Past experiences may come with them scars of bad decision in future.

So individual should learn from past experiences, do their thorough analysis adapt new changes in present to achieve good judgement.

This holds immense relevance in today's world where people gives up too early with initial failure.

As Bruce Lee has said -

"Knowing is not enough, one must apply it, willing is not enough, one should do it" we must inculcate learning from past

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Carefully removing baggage of emotions attached to past.

To conclude, success is not easy step. it may involve ups and downs, failures presents us an opportunity for improvement to succeed in future ultimately it is path to success.

We must learn and inculcate experience gained from past bad decisions in order to arrive at good decision in present. We must remind ourselves about our past experiences while dealing with present complexities in order to achieve a progressive future for all and make this world a more better place to live. As saying go "well begin is half done," now it is time to take action!

Police started victimising her father to accept their version of story that developed was that one of her 'jilted boyfriend' could have done this in revenge. She was denied right to free and fair trials and right to justice, a basic human right.

Here what was her fault? Perhaps she should have known that despite being a good student, good daughter, she is a 'women' in society. Forget about privileges, she is denied basic right of equality and control over her own in life. Empowerment of women does not mean that women overriding men.

in all possible domain. It is more about Equality, fighting for own right, having control over her own life and body. That's what real meaning of empowerment which will allow her choice of her free will and unleash her potential.

Do women have control over themselves? We all are born free with immense potential and multiple future identities. But all these possibilities and potentials of women are curbed systematically in society where they live, grow up and work. Even her birth into this beautiful world is controlled via sex selective abortion weaponising technology against her; and denying her elemental right

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to enter in this world. She is not welcomed in some as a boy child born. with vigour, festives and huge celebration.

In childhood, she faces the discrimination even in family with respect to resources, opportunities. be it in education, hobby, play, health or any other domain. Her choices to higher education are limited restricted to her home science, humanities, arts.

Reports points out dismal low proportion of women in 'STEM' sector which is traditionally considered as men dominated sectors. Here she is not fighting for more preiviliges or more to outnumber men but to ensure her right to equation education and equality.

forget about resources, women does not have control over bodily autonomy and physical health. the restrictive state abortion laws hinders her basic reproductive right on one hand, while marital rape hurts her autonomy and consent every now and then.

In market economy which is supposedly free and open restricts her access to top positions i.e. the concept of 'glass ceiling' in corporate wide wage gap add more to the complexities. moreover safety and security at work place is issue that hinder her right to livelihood and right to occupation

Recent Kolkata doctor, rape Case where she was raped at work place brutally tortured leaving multiple fractures, injuries over her body. What was her fault? Perhaps she was demanding equal right to practice higher education away from home or her dressing style or what not. The case has shaken core of entire society highlighting safety and security concern at work place.

Moreover she is not at home also. NCRB data shows around 32% of married women have faced some kind of domestic violence in their lifetime. Dowry death incidents still has not subsided at least in rural part where she is traded like a commodity in market place.

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Another significant concern about women is intersectionality of social identities where a women with disability or a women from lower Caste groups suffer much more disproportionately. This makes her life more herculean task. Empowerment for such women does not mean outperforming men or being top at hierarchy above men. They are fighting for basic rights to Lead decent life.

Empowerment means she should have control on her body, mind, skill activities, and occupation. There is much more needed in present context to achieve Equality in gender. Socialism is most important tool for women empowerment right from childhood.

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We should learn from 'Japan' where civic values and gender equality are inculcated right from childhood. Family should provide equal opportunities to both genders without any discrimination. Societal prejudices, stereotypes, belief shacks need to be removed in order to free women in real sense.

Access to higher education can be enhanced by sponsoring partially financially, giving subsidies or incentives.

West Bengal's Project 'Kanyashree Pokshp' is innovative approach where child marriage is delayed and gets financial incentives for higher education.

Recent move by central government to bring 'Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam' 2023 to reserve 33% of seats in Lok Sabha and state legislatures.

assembly holds good promise. But to bring some tangible impact focus should be on skilling women leaders, supporting, mentoring them otherwise they will be dummy candidate and Sarpanch pati model of lower level will replicate there.

Recent changes in market like work from home, flexible work schedule, gig economy, digital market present new opportunities for women to increase presence in financial market ensure financial autonomy. Having control over own finances is most basic step that will lead to further empowerment. financial inclusion and digital skilling, literacy are much needed step for empowerment.

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We have ample of examples where women have broken societal chains and have unleashed their potential. Falguni Mayar CEO of most famous cosmetic brand Mayaki illustrates example how empowerment can lead to breaking glass ceiling and asserts own rights in society.

Nobel lauret Malala Yousufzai would not have won nobel prize, had she not shown lion's heart in face of adversity, had she not shown courage after being hit by bullet in head. She provides real meaning to phrase

"when going gets tougher,
tough gets going"

struggle will make women more harder and strengthful. so it is time for women to rise and assert their right for equality and



justice. They have to take their action in order to change their future.

Our protagonist Parul, is unfortunately no more in world. Post-humously her mother fought legal battle and get her character certified in Court. But many such Paruls are awaiting justice in society. It is our responsibility to action for their justice. Actions by an individual or few people may not move mountain but can surely cast a stone in water creating multiple ripples!
