1. OPEC+

Why in News?

The Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and its allies, known as OPEC+, may consider wrapping up their oil output reduction in 2020.

• OPEC+ has been capping its output since 2017 in order to balance out the supply and demand in the global oil market as well as prop up oil prices.

About OPEC+

- Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC):
 - It is a permanent, intergovernmental Organisation, created at the Baghdad Conference in 1960, by Iran, Iraq, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia and Venezuela.
 - It is a cartel that aims to manage the supply of oil in an effort to set the price of oil in the world market.
 - Its objective is to coordinate and unify petroleum policies among Member Countries, in order to secure fair and stable prices for petroleum producers.
 - Any country, which is a substantial exporter of oil, can join the OPEC. Congo was the latest member to join it in 2018.
 - o It publishes the World Oil Outlook.
 - o **Headquarters:** Vienna, Austria.
