## 160 Tourist Places to be Developed in Bihar in Three Years

### Why In News?

On November 2, 2022, the Tourism Department of Bihar has decided to increase the facilities in the routes of all the tourism circuits of the state. Under this, 160 tourist destinations will be developed in 3 years.

### Key Points

- The Tourism Department will provide all kinds of online facilities including accommodation and entertainment to the tourists on the way to all the tourist places of the state.
- In the year 2019, the total number of domestic and foreign tourists in Bihar was 3.51 crore, while in the year 2022, till August, more than 84 lakh domestic and more than 12 thousand foreign tourists have come.
- The Tourism Department has prepared four models - premium route facility, standard route facility, basic route facility and existing route facility to increase the facilities of the routes of tourist places.
- Under the premium road facility, premium facilities will be developed over a distance of 50 km in about one and a half acres of land.
- On the other hand, under the standard road facility, standard facilities will be provided at a distance of 30 km in one acre of land.
- Basic road facility will be developed over a distance of 30 km, for which 7500 square feet of land will be used.
- The last existing road facilities will be further improved. 160 centers will be set up under these four models, with a maximum increase of 10%.
- To develop public facilities, the tourism department will give 10, 20, 35 and 50 lakh rupees or 50 percent grant to the investors.

## Pro. Sudha Sinha Gets Dinanath Sharan Samman-2022

### Why In News?

On November 3, 2022, renowned philosopher and poet of Bihar, **Prof. Sudha Sinha** was awarded the

**Dinanath Sharan Samman-2022** by Chitragupta Samajik Sansthan, Patna.

### Key Point

- It is known that Prof. Sudha Sinha has been the Chairperson of the Department of Philosophy of Patna University.
- It is noteworthy that **Dr. Dinanath Sharan was a mystic critic of humanity and life-values. As a conscious poet, he weaponised poetry against exploitation and hypocrisy** and throughout his life he continued to do solitary service to literature and journalism.
- Dinanath Sharan's fame came from the criticism-book '**Hindi Kavya Men Chhayavad**' written by him. He also established the '**Department of Hindi**' at Tribhuvan University in Kathmandu, doing a very important work in the promotion of Hindi in Nepal.
- Dinanath Sharan Samman is given every year, under which the honored person is given a sum of Rs 11,000 along with citation and floral garlands.

## Uttarakhand Becomes First State in the Country to Register Nikshay Mitra

### Why In News?

On November 3, 2022, **Uttarakhand Health Minister Dr. Dhan Singh Rawat** informed that **Uttarakhand has secured the first position in the country by registering the highest number of Nikshay Mitras** in the **Prime Minister's TB Free India Campaign**.

### Key Point

- Uttarakhand has become the state with the highest number of Nikshay Mitra registrations across the country based on the average number of TB patients. Any person including elected representatives, political parties, NGOs, corporate institutions can register as Nikshay Mitra.
- As Nikshay Mitra, **each person will support the treatment of one or more TB patients by adopting them for at least one year and Nikshay Mitra will provide food baskets suggested by the Central Government to the patient every month, estimated to cost one thousand rupees.**

Note:



- Health Minister Dr. Dhan Singh Rawat said that in three districts of the state - **Tehri Garhwal, Chamoli and Champawat**, 100 percent Nikshay Mitras have been linked for patient care and treatment, while in five districts Almora, Bageshwar, Rudraprayag, Udham Singh Nagar and Uttarkashi, more than 95 percent Nikshay Mitras have been linked.
- It is noteworthy that under the **Pradhan Mantri TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyan, 5852 Nikshay Mitras** have been made in the state so far. Of these, 91 per cent of the Nikshay Mitras have been linked to TB patients.

## Preparations Begin for World-class Ganga Path in Patna

### Why in News?

In a meeting chaired by Bihar Deputy Chief Minister Tejashwi Prasad Yadav on November 7, 2022, it was decided that JP Ganga Path will soon be connected with world-class and recreational facilities for people of all age groups.

### Key Points

- Sharing information in this regard on social media, Deputy Chief Minister Tejashwi Prasad Yadav said that it was decided in the meeting that Ganga Path will be divided into **cultural, sports, entertainment, senior citizens and children's areas**.
- The Deputy Chief Minister said that once developed, the Ganga Path will look so wonderful that people from all over the world will come to see the road and proposed facilities along the river Ganga. Work on the proposals will begin soon.
- According to sources, the entire stretch of Ganga path is proposed to be developed into different clusters. Water sports facilities like speed boats and jet skiing have been planned under the sports category. Similarly, there are plans to organize regular cultural activities to attract visitors along the river.
- In addition, there will be a vending zone for all vehicles and kiosks. A cycle track is also proposed, while landscaping work will be done to beautify the road.
- 20.5 km on the banks of the Ganges between Digha and Nasriganj. The long JP Ganga Path was envisaged in 2010 as a part of the Nitish Kumar government's Vision 2021 for the development of Patna. Its foundation stone was laid by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar in 2013.

- The first phase of the Ganga Path between Digha and PMCH was inaugurated by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on June 24 this year. This phase of the project is 7.4 km long, of which 6.5 km is semi-advanced, with a 13 meter high dam built on the banks of the Ganges.

## Hooter will be used to Save from Lightning in Bihar

### Why In News?

According to information received from official sources of Bihar State Disaster Authority on November 11, 2022, the authority has decided to install hooters in all districts to save people from lightning, so that people can get information about lightning 40 minutes in advance.

### Key Points

- According to official sources, under the pilot project, this hooter will be used in Aurangabad, Patna and Gaya districts. It will be launched by January.
- At present, the information of falling thunder is given 30 minutes before the Indra Vajra app. More than 1.25 lakh people have downloaded this app, but the problem is not going away in rural areas. Farmers working in the fields are not getting this message due to the non-availability of mobiles. For this reason, the authority has decided to install hooters in the villages.
- Authority officials said that the sound of the hooter is five kilometers. will go up. The hooter will ring half an hour before the fall. Farmers working in the fields will also move to a safer place as soon as they hear its sound.
- Apart from this, a lightning driver will also be installed, which has been started. This device will be installed on government buildings and it will attract the rain falling within an area of 130 meters.
- Significantly, every year many people die due to lightning in Bihar. Due to increase in incidents of lightning in Bihar, the death toll has also increased. In the last five years, 1475 people have died due to lightning.
- According to the annual lightning report 2021-22 released in June 2022, Bihar is at the tenth position in terms of lightning. During this, 2,59,266 incidents of thunderstorms were recorded in Bihar, which is 23 percent less than in 2020-21. Earlier in the year 2018, 3000 people had died due to lightning across the country, out of which 302 people were from Bihar.

Note:

At the same time, the death toll due to lightning in 2019 stood at 221.

- In Bihar, four lakh rupees are paid by the government as ex-gratia grant to the dependents of people who die due to lightning or any natural calamity.
- It is known that due to the friction of the clouds present in the sky, an electricity is generated, due to which negative charge is generated. At the same time, positive charge is already present in the earth. Both negative and positive charges are attracted towards each other. When a conductor comes between these two charges, there is an electric discharge, but there is no conductor in the sky, then this electric discharge falls to the earth in the form of a drop.

## Kahalgaon gets 'Swarna Shakti Safety' Award on NTPC's 48th Foundation Day

### Why In News?

Recently, NTPC Kahalgaon 'of Bhagalpur district of Bihar was awarded the coveted 'Swarna Shakti Trophy' for its outstanding work in Security (O&M) category at the 'Swarna Shakti Award' program of NTPC's 48<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day celebrations.

### Key Points

- It is known that the 48<sup>th</sup> NTPC Foundation Day function was organized on 11<sup>th</sup> November in New Delhi.
- NTPC awards NTPC Swarna Shakti Awards are given to projects every year with an aim to motivate employees to perform better and achieve the goals of the organization.
- The award is given for better performance in the areas of productivity, safety, employee relations, environmental protection and improvement, official language, best health facilities, CSR and community development and project management.
- Executive Director (Ex-I) DSGSS Babji and Chief General Manager of Kahalgaon Project Arindam Sinha received the award on behalf of RK Singh, Cabinet Minister, Department of Power, New and Renewable Energy.
- It is noteworthy that this year the accident rate in plant operation in NTPC's Kahalgaon project was zero and overhauling work was also accident free. In order to create awareness about safety among the

employees and working contractual workers in this project, programs on road safety, electrical safety, fire safety, home safety were organized by the security department throughout the year. Due to this the Kahalgaon project was declared as the best among all the NTPC projects in the country in this area.

## Acharya Somdev Passed Away

### Why In News?

On November 14, 2022, Acharya Somdev, an experimental writer of Maithili literature of Bhojpur district of Bihar, passed away.

### Key Points

- Giving this information, senior litterateur Vibhuti Anand said that born on February 24, 1934, Somdev had filled new energy in Maithili literature after 'Yatri-Nagarjuna'. Starting with Prayogavad (a collection of poems by Kaaldhwani, whose famous role was written by Dr. Dharendra), he did a variety of experiments.
- Based on traditional folk tunes, he wrote many folk songs, which became very popular. Along with Doha in poetry, he also used different types of experiments in novels. His written 'Charpatiya' is still on the tongue of the people.
- Gaurishankar, i.e. Somdev, had chosen Darbhanga as his field of work. For a decade, he also lived with his son in Saharsa.
- Somdev, who was awarded with Sahitya Akademi, brought the use of pocket books in Maithili for the first time. He wrote novels like 'Hotel Anarkali' in Maithili as an experiment. His books like Som Padavali, Charaveti, Chanodai were popular at Sahasmukhi Chowk.
- Acharya Somdev also translated 'Meghdoot' and 'Namdev' in Marathi along with the works of Yatri-Nagarjuna. His story 'Bhaat' is considered to be a milestone. He also edited and published newspapers and magazines like 'Mithila Bhoomi' and 'Mithila Times'. During the Naxalbari movement, he also published 'Agni Sankalan' and edited Maithili's famous magazine 'Vaidehi'.
- Acharya Somdev has also been awarded 'Yatri Chetna Puraskar', 'Subhadra Kumari Chauhan Centenary Award' etc.

## Union Minister Nitin Gadkari Inaugurated and Laid the Foundation Stone of Projects in Bihar

### Why In News?

On November 14, 2022, Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari inaugurated two national highway projects worth Rs 3,390 crore in Buxar, Bihar and laid the foundation stone of an elevated bridge at Rohtas.

### Key Points

- Inaugurating two National Highway projects in Buxar, Minister Nitin Gadkari said that the 44 km long 4-lane Koilwar to Bhojpur section of National Highway-922 has been completed at a cost of Rs 1662 crore.
- Similarly, the 48 km 4-lane Bhojpur to Buxar section on NH-922 has been constructed at a cost of Rs 1728 crore.
- Speaking on the occasion, the Union Minister said that with the construction of these two projects, connectivity to purvanchal expressway will be easier. With this, the time taken to reach the national capital Delhi from Bihar via Lucknow will now be reduced to 10 hours.
- This road will provide relief to the people from traffic jams in Ara and it will be easier for agricultural products to access the new market. At the same time, the construction of Ganga bridge will facilitate traffic between north and south Bihar. The 37 underpasses on this route will facilitate the movement of pedestrians and vehicles.
- Union Minister Nitin Gadkari inaugurated the 1.5 km long 2-lane elevated R.C.C. to be built near Panduka on Son River in Rohtas, Bihar. He also laid the foundation stone of the bridge. Its construction is estimated to cost Rs 210 crore.
- With the construction of this bridge, National Highway-19 and National Highway-39 will be directly connected. After the construction of the bridge, traffic movement between Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh and Chhattisgarh will be easier.
- The Union Minister said that at present Panduka in Rohtas district and Garhwa district of Jharkhand have to travel a distance of 150 km to reach Srinagar and

the construction of the elevated bridge would save about four hours in this travel time. Now with the help of the bridge, the traffic pressure on Dehri bridge will also reduce and cities like Aurangabad and Sasaram will be free from the problem of jam.

## Earthquake Clinics

### Why In News?

According to information received from the media on November 16, 2022, the Bihar state government has decided to open 'Earthquake Clinics' in every district of the state in order to prevent earthquakes.

### Key Points

- According to the information, under this initiative, these clinics have been opened in the state capital Patna, Muzaffarpur and Bhagalpur.
- Significantly, earthquake tremors are coming one after the other these days. Many times there is a lot of loss of life and property due to earthquakes. To avoid damage caused by earthquakes, many types of initiatives are taken by the state governments, such as spreading awareness about safety measures among the people, etc. In this sequence, the Bihar government has decided to open earthquake clinics in every district of the state by starting this initiative.
- In these clinics, people will be told about the houses made of brick and cement to be built in such areas. Here the engineers will tell how to prepare the foundation of the house, as well as the depth of the pillar, the size of the rod and how to use it. Along with this, information about ventilation in the house will also be given. Similarly, information will also be given about keeping houses built from bamboo and grass safe.
- Many times it happens that builders mislead people by showing fear of earthquake and also do their marketing. In such a situation, the earthquake clinic will also spread awareness among the people.
- National Disaster Management Force teams at earthquake clinics warn people of its danger. They do mock drills etc. for this. Training on how to protect yourself at the time of an earthquake is also given in the earthquake clinic. Apart from this, how to build houses in earthquake-dominated areas, how to rebuild disaster-affected houses, etc. are also told in these earthquake clinics.

Note:

- An earthquake is a natural disaster that can occur anywhere, anytime. Considering the possibility of earthquakes, the areas are divided on the basis of seismic zones. Bihar has been placed under seismic zone-4. According to experts, given seismic zone 4, if an earthquake of magnitude .5 hits Bihar, the possibility of large-scale damage cannot be ruled out.

## **School on the Lines of Simultala Residential School**

### **Why In News?**

On November 18, 2022, Bihar Education Minister Prof. Chandrashekhar, while talking to reporters at the Secretariat at Vikas Bhawan in Patna, said that in order to improve the quality of education, schools will be opened on the lines of Simultala Residential School at every district headquarters level of the state.

### **Key Points**

- Prof. Chandrasekhar said Simultala residential school is a better model of school education. This school has given many toppers and admission is given through entrance examination in this school.
- He said that 3.38 lakh posts of teachers are vacant in Bihar. However, there are not enough CTET / STET pass candidates to fill so many posts. Even after all this, the seventh phase of teacher planning will start soon and its preparation is in the final stages.
- He said that a concrete policy will be made for the transfer of teachers. Among the teachers, especially women, disabled and needy teachers, transfers have become necessary. The government will take serious steps in this direction.

## **Statue of Sita Mata**

### **Why In News?**

On November 19, 2022, Bihar MP Sunil Kumar Pintu said that preparations have started to install a 257 feet tall statue of Sita Mata at Radhopur Bakhri in Sitamarhi district of the state. Its construction work will start soon.

### **Key Points**

- It is known that the tallest statue of Sita Mata in the country will be installed at Radhopur Bakhri in

Sitamarhi. It will be constructed by the Ramayana Research Council.

- Sunil Kumar said that 18 acres of 40 decimal land has been donated to the council of Manhat of Radhopur Bakhri. Nearby farmers have also signed an agreement to give about 6 acres of land. In all, the council has so far signed an agreement for 24.39 acres of land. Discussions have also been held with the President and the Prime Minister in this regard.
- He said that people of every religion and class are helping in making this statue in Sitamarhi. The country's first cultural embassy centre will also be set up here.
- It is to be noted that the Rath Yatra will be flagged off from January 14 to promote the statue of Sita Mata to be installed in Sitamarhi. This rath yatra will tour the entire country.

## **Film Production Sector will Also get Subsidy in Bihar**

### **Why In News?**

On November 21, 2022, in order to encourage film production in Bihar, the state government has made a new film policy to give industry status to the film production sector, soon proposals related to the film policy will be sent to the cabinet for approval.

### **Key Points**

- Bihar's Art, Culture and Youth Affairs Department has finalized a policy to encourage film making.
- With films getting industry status, people engaged in film production will also get the benefits of subsidy, single window system and other facilities like the industry.
- Under the new policy, if a producer shoots 75 percent of his film in Bihar, he will be given a subsidy according to the cost.
- A single window system has been provided for taking all clearances related to film production, for which Bihar Film Production Corporation has been made the nodal agency.
- At present, the benefit of subsidy will be available to those who make films in Hindi, Bhojpuri, Magahi, Maithili, Angika and Bajjika languages.
- According to the new provision, if a film is awarded at a national and international festival, it will be given additional subsidy.

Note:

- The new film policy also provides for subsidy to increase infrastructure in multiplexes and cinema halls. Right now, many cinema halls in the state are closed or not built in a modern way. In this, subsidy will be given according to the cost.
- With this policy, the government hopes that employment opportunities will increase in the state, local artists and technicians will get employment and respect due to the shooting of films in the state. The State Film Development Corporation will prepare a list of such artists and technicians and also determine their remuneration.
- For the development of the film, the government has taken responsibility from the Tourism Department and given it to the Art, Culture and Youth Department. The department has made the Film Development Corporation the nodal agency for this.
- It is noteworthy that superhit films like Gandhi in Bihar, Manjhi The Mountain Man in Gaya and Half Girlfriend have been shot at Gandhi Ghat on the banks of Ganga in Patna.

## **Integrated Dual Degree Program**

### **Why In News?**

On November 22, 2022, IIT Patna has signed an MoU with The National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) Mumbai for the Integrated Dual Degree Program, under which IIT Patna students can now study Bachelor of Technology (BTech) as well as Master of Business Administration (MBA).

### **Key Points**

- IIT Director Prof T.N Singh said that the Integrated Dual Degree Program will be of five years duration. This will be a full time residential program on the campus of IIT Patna and NITIE Mumbai. Interested and eligible students will undertake B.Tech course work as well as required course work from third year onwards.
- In the final semester (Eighth Semester), students will be able to visit the campus of NITIE Mumbai to complete the program in the next 18 months. IIT Patna will offer B.Tech and MBA degrees.
- Students can specialize in different areas of MBA. Students will be able to specialize in 10 different

areas along with marketing, business, finance, project analytics, innovation and entrepreneurship. According to the MoU, both the institutes will train students on the basis of their respective capacities.

- Pro. T.N Singh said that IIT Patna is currently running undergraduate and postgraduate programs in engineering and science. The aim of this collaboration is to meet other market needs and to develop techno-managerial competence among the students.
- Students will develop their skills in technical subjects at technical institutes and managerial skills at NITIE Mumbai. After this, all these students will work on the growing demand of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning in the business world and market. Keeping these needs in mind, Integrated Dual Degree will be started.
- It is noteworthy that NITIE has been consistently ranked among the top B-schools in India. NITIE is committed to produce skilled professionals to meet the growing engineering and management needs of the country. National Institute of Industrial Engineering has been designated by the Ministry of Education as the nodal hub for promoting the PM Gati Shakti Master Plan.

## **1890 Government Schools of Bihar got Solar Power**

### **Why In News?**

Recently, in a meeting chaired by Additional Chief Secretary of Bihar Education Department Deepak Kumar Singh, it was informed that under the 'Jal-Jeevan-Hariyali Abhiyan', roof top solar power plants have been installed in 1890 government schools of Bihar.

### **Key Points**

- The roof top solar power plants that have been installed on the roof of these government schools in the state are grid connected.
- Deepak Kumar Singh told that there are 1230 schools in these schools, whose approved power load is two kilowatt peak.
- He said that roof top solar power plants will be installed on the roof of basic schools and Kasturba Gandhi Balika Residential Schools in the districts where Shiksha Bhawan has been constructed.
- **Director of Bihar Renewable Energy Development Agency (BREDA)** said that it is mandatory to take a

three-phase connection in the buildings where the connection of approved electricity load above **15 kW peak** is and this connection will be installed.

- It was decided in the meeting that a hybrid solar power plant of 15 kW peak will be installed in the administrative buildings of District Institute of Education and Training (DIET). Apart from this, grid connected roof top power plants will also be installed on other buildings.
- In the meeting, the BRENDA Director requested the officers of the Education Department that in schools where there is a connection of less than two kilowatt peak electricity load, the consumer number should be given so that the district agency can be informed.
- It was informed in the meeting that solar power plants will be installed in all schools and other buildings of the Education Department. Apart from this, IIT Patna will set up state-of-the-art science labs in 50 model higher secondary schools of Bihar.
- The Model Science Lab is to be set up in two phases. In the first phase, science labs will be set up in seven higher secondary schools of Patna district at a cost of Rs 1.05 crore and in the second phase, the remaining 43 labs will be set up. At least one model lab must be set up in each district.

## 'Gangajal Supply Scheme'

### *Why In News?*

On November 27, 2022, Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar launched the ambitious 'Gangajal Supply Scheme' in Rajgir.

### *Key Points*

- This is the chief minister's unique vision of taking surplus water from river Ganga to water-stressed cities in south Bihar and using it as drinking water under a far-reaching campaign 'Jal-Jeevan-Hariyali'. The ambitious 'Ganga Water Supply Scheme' was approved in a special cabinet meeting held in Gaya in December 2019 under his chairmanship.
- Under the guidance of the Chief Minister, the Water Resources Department has worked with alacrity and completed such a big scheme in less than three years despite the challenges of the Corona period.
- Ganga water has been transported from Hathidah to Rajgir, Gaya, Bodh Gaya and Nawada through 11

powerful pumps. A detention centre has been set up in Rajgir.

- 151 km through Ganga water pipeline. After traveling it has reached the reservoirs of Rajgir, Gaya and Bodh Gaya, from where it will be purified and quench the thirst of millions of people daily in the form of pure drinking water.
- Under this scheme, Gangajal will be supplied as pure drinking water to about 8031 houses in 19 wards of Rajgir city, about 75000 houses in 53 wards of Gaya city and about 6000 houses in 19 wards of Bodh Gaya city. Under the scheme, the target is to supply 135 liters of pure water per person per day.
- Apart from this, water will also be supplied to the city's institutions, hospitals, hotels etc., so that pure water can be supplied to the large number of tourists and devotees coming to these cities. Ganga water will also be supplied to the animals and plants of Nature Safari kept in Rajgir Zoo Safari.
- On this occasion, the Chief Minister said that the Jarasandh Memorial would be built near the Jarasandh Akhara. This will enhance the knowledge of the tourists.

## Bihar Cabinet Approves 31 Major Decisions

### *Why In News?*

- On November 29, 2022, 31 important agendas were stamped in the cabinet meeting chaired by Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar in Patna.

### *Key Points*

- Some of the important decisions taken in the cabinet meeting are as follows:
  - The Cabinet has approved the formation of Bihar Archaeological and Museum Service Amendment. Apart from this, approval has been given to publish amendments in **Bihar Excise Rules 2001**.
  - In this meeting, Sevika Selection Guide 2022 under integrated child development services scheme has been approved. Apart from this, now the Sevika selection process will be done online, while the minimum matriculation qualification has been fixed for inter and Sahayika for Sevika.
  - The death anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel will be celebrated as a state function on December 15 every year.

## Names of 29 Bihar Police Officers Recommended for President's Medal

### Why In News?

On November 28, 2022, according to the information received from the media. The names of **29 police officers and personnel of the state** have been recommended by the Bihar government for the **President's Medal**.

### Key Points

- According to media reports, **names of 7 police officers and personnel have been sent for Vishisht Seva Medal and 22 policemen for meritorious service**. In the Vishisht Seva Medal category, the names of a total of seven officers include three IPS officers and four second-rank officers.
- The names of IPS officers ADG Ravindran Shankaran, ADG Parasnath and ADG Bachchu Singh Meena and four second-rank officers Vinay Kumar Sharma, Binay Krishna, Dilip Kumar Singh and Ranjit Kumar have been recommended.
- According to media reports, the names of the policemen who have been recommended for the Meritorious Service Medal are **Rupesh Thapa, Sanjay Kumar Chaurasia, Sanjay Kumar, Mukhtar Ali, Dhananjay Kumar, Dharmaraj Sharma, Baidyanath Kumar, Alok Kumar, Akshaybar Pandey, Satyendra Kumar, Sikander Kumar, Panchratna Prasad Gond, Alamnath Bhuiya, Devendra Kumar, Santosh Kumar Dixit, Sanjay Kumar Shekhar, Sarwar Khan, Om Prakash Singh, Rasbihari Chaudhary and Vinay Kumar**.
- President's medals are given to police personnel twice every year. The names are finalized before Republic Day and Independence Day and the names of the selected policemen are announced. The names are recommended by the state government and central paramilitary forces to the Home Ministry and the screening committee under the ministry reviews it and selects the names for the medals.
