'e-Learning' Scheme

Why In News?

- On May 5, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar has launched the 'e-Learning' scheme from Rohtak district of the state.

Key Point

- While launching the scheme, the Chief Minister distributed tablets to the students of government schools.
- The tablet distribution ceremony has been held at 119 locations in the state.
- He said the **new education policy** has set a target of 2030 to implement the scheme of imparting education by adopting technology across the country, while the Haryana government is determined to implement it by 2025.
- Haryana is the first state to announce tablets for children of classes 9 to 12.
- He said, Haryana spends the largest part of its budget on the education sector. In this year's budget alone, 20 thousand crore rupees are being spent on education.
- Announcing on the occasion, the Chief Minister said that the government is going to set up two task forces for the education sector. One task force will work in schools on other essential requirements including infrastructure, building, boundary walls, beauty, sanitation, pathways, water and toilets of schools, while the other task force will ensure the provision of furniture etc.

Haryana Aerospace and Defence Production Policy, 2022

Why In News?

- The '**Haryana Aerospace and Defence Production Policy, 2022**' was approved in the Cabinet meeting chaired by Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar on May 6, 2022.

Key Point

- The objective of the policy is to attract investment of US\$ 1 billion over the next five years with a focus on promoting industrial development in the aerospace and defence sector and creating a complete ecosystem for the development of the sector and to establish Haryana as the leading aerospace and defence hub of the country by creating employment opportunities for about 25,000 people.
- The policy envisages harnessing haryana's inherent strength in auto components and automobile manufacturing sector.
- Through this policy, the Government of Haryana is committed to various steps to promote human capital development in the State, such as curriculum development, Research and Innovation Scholarship Programme, Aerospace and Defence University and setting up of flying schools.
- The policy will also meet the need to create a world class MRO in Haryana. At the same time, this policy lays special emphasis on the development of the MSME sector and the development of its business.
- The state government will facilitate and encourage proposals for setting up of new MRO facilities at the existing airports or new locations in Haryana.
- Cluster development, market linkages and international cooperation, enhancing access to infrastructure and technology, regulatory simplification, infrastructure support and financial incentives have been envisaged to accelerate the growth of the MSME sector in the State and to promote entrepreneurship.
- The financial incentives offered under this policy are as under:
 - 100% of net SGST will be reimbursed for 10 years in D category blocks to the extent of 12.5 % of FCI.
 - 75% of the net SGST will be reimbursed for 8 years in C category blocks.
 - 50% of the net SGST will be reimbursed for 7 years in B category blocks.
 - Within a radius of 10 km of B, C and D blocks and all airstrips (except Hisar Airport) in Haryana, 5% of the Fixed Capital Investment (FCI), the maximum limit is Rs. 10 crore.

Note:



- Integrated Manufacturing Cluster, 5% of The Fixed Capital Investment (FCI), maximum limit of Rs.20 crore, will be invested in a radius of 10 kms around Hisar and Maharaja Agrasen Airport, Hisar (MAH).
- A subsidy of Rs.48,000/- per annum will be provided to all categories of employees having salary above Rs.40,000/- per month in B, C and D blocks.
- The aerospace and defence units in B, C and D blocks will be eligible for reimbursement of 100% stamp duty on sale/lease deed after commencement of commercial production within 5 years from the date of purchase of land.
- 100% waiver in electricity charges for 10 years in B, C and D blocks.
- A credit guarantee scheme will be offered to students pursuing aviation/aerospace related course in higher education.
- In order to facilitate research and innovation in the State, the units registered with the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research will be provided financial assistance @ 50% of the project cost subject to a maximum of Rs. 50 crore.

New Chairman of Haryana Renewable Energy Development Agency (HAREDA) appointed

Why In News?

- The Haryana government on May 6, 2022, has appointed **Swatantra Kumar Singhal** as the chairman of **Haryana Renewable Energy Development Agency (HAREDA)**.

Key Point

- Singhal was appointed as Director General, Department of New and Renewable Energy, Dr. Hanif took over in the presence of Qureshi.
- Singhal is a Master of Engineering from Roorkee University and has served as administrator, planner and consultant in the government and private sector as well as in various organizations.

- As soon as he assumes charge, newly appointed Director General Singhal has called for implementing the plan to make Haryana and adjoining National Capital Region pollution free from a scientific point of view to tackle the problem of paddy stubble burning in the fields to give a boost to the renewable energy and energy conservation programmes in Haryana.
- Apart from this, he said that efforts will be made to harness solar energy through small solar power plants. These efforts will not only generate employment but also contribute to the clean and green economy of the state.

Khelo India Youth Games 2021

Why In News

- On May 7, 2022, the fourth season of the Khelo India Youth Games got off to a grand and grand start at The Indradhanush Auditorium in Panchkula.

Key Point

- The launch event was attended by the launch of the mascot, logo, jersey and theme song of khelo India Youth Games in the presence of Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar and Union Minister for Sports, Youth Affairs and Information and Broadcasting Anurag Thakur.
- The 'Khelo India Youth Games, 2021' is being organized jointly by the State Government and the Sports Authority of India (SAI), Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports from June 4 to June 13, 2022. The grand event will have 25 types of sports, including five traditional sports, namely, Gatka, Kalaripayattu, Thang-Ta, Malkhamb and Yogasana. The games will be held at five venues- Panchkula, Ambala, Shahbad, Chandigarh and Delhi. More than 8,000 athletes will participate in the Khelo India Youth Games, 2021.
- The Chief Minister informed that for organizing these Games, tau Devi Lal Sports Complex, Hockey Astro turf, Volleyball Indoor Hall and Basketball Indoor Hall at Panchkula and indoor swimming pool of international standard at Ambala have been constructed, as well as synthetic athletics track, badminton hall etc.

Vehicle Scrapping Facility Centre inaugurated at Fatehpur village in Nuh district

Why In News?

- On May 10, 2022, Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari inaugurated the Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility Centre at Fatehpur village in Nuh district.

Key Point

- Speaking on the occasion, he said that the vehicle scrapping policy brought by the Central Government will reduce pollution, while also increasing the production capacity in the automobile sector with lower cost.
- The biggest benefit of this policy will be that copper, steel, aluminium, rubber and plastic will be easily available.
- It may be recalled that the Vehicle Scrapping Policy was announced by the Central Government in the year 2021, the salient points of which are as follows:
 - Commercial vehicles older than 15 years and private vehicles older than 20 years will have to pass a fitness test before re-registration.
 - The testing of old vehicles will be done at the automatic fitness centre, here the fitness test of vehicles will be done on international standards.
 - The State Governments are advised to provide road tax exemption upto 25% for private vehicles and up to 15% for commercial vehicles to encourage owners of old vehicles to remove old and unfit vehicles.
 - Those showing 'scrapping certificate' by vehicle manufacturers will be given a discount of 5% on taking the new car, along with the registration fee of the new vehicle.
 - The use of such vehicles will be discouraged by increasing the re-registration fee of vehicles 15 years and older.

First Tetrapack Plant To Be Set Up in Rohtak

Why in News?

- On May 11, 2022, Haryana's Cooperation Minister Dr. Banwari Lal informed that Haryana's first Tetrapack

plant for packing liquid milk, fruit juices and fermented milk products would be set up in Rohtak.

Key Points

- This plant, which will be set up at a cost of Rs 125 crore, will enable long-term storage of liquid products and keep them safe. Rohtak Vita Plant currently has a production capacity of 4.5 lakh liters per day.
- Dr. Banwari Lal, after laying the foundation stone of butter deep freezer to be set up at a cost of Rs 5.5 crore at Vita Plant, Rohtak, said that one thousand metric tonnes of butter can be saved due to the installation of butter deep freezer for white butter storage in Vita plant.
- This plant supplies milk, Vita Ghee, Vita Butter, Curd, Namkeen Lassi, Buttermilk, Paneer and Barfi etc. as well as Vita Ghee and Milk to the Indian Army and children under Mid-Day-Mid Meal, Anganwadi Scheme and Sports Schemes. To meet the milk demand of the players, sweet flavored milk powder is also being supplied.
- A target has also been set to establish a new SFSMP plant in this plant at a cost of Rs 4 crore.
- On this occasion, he also informed that along with sugar, jaggery and sugar are being produced in Palwal, Kaithal and Meham cooperative sugar mills. At the same time, an ethanol plant has been started at Shahabad Sugar Mill.

2nd RoundTable in the context of global city project

Why In News

- On May 11, 2022, the second Round Table Conference was held in Mumbai under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar in the context of seeking major real estate developers and real estate focused funds for the Global City Project to be set up in Gurugram, Haryana.

Key Point

- The Global City Project will be developed under the aegis of Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, which is a nodal agency of the Government.

Note:

- The Chief Minister said that through this project, Gurugram will be developed as a central business district. It focuses on modern technology sectors and future oriented industries, low carbon green infrastructure, easy living, skill development of people and creating jobs.
- Speaking on the occasion, Vikas Gupta, Managing Director, Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, said that it is a mixed land use project, which is being developed in Sectors 36B, 37A and 37B in Gurugram with the under-construction 8-lane Dwarka Expressway on an area of about 1003 acres on an area of about 1003 acres in the residential and commercial hub being developed in Sectors 36B, 37A and 37B in Gurugram along the under-construction 8-lane Dwarka Expressway on an area of about 1003 acres of 'city within a city' Imagine developing as.

First Forest Research Institute In Haryana

Why In news

- On May 15, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar announced the setting up of the first forest research institute at Jagadhari in Yamunanagar at a cost of Rs 50 crore to promote the plywood industry in the state.

Key Point

- This was announced by the Chief Minister while addressing the gathering at the Haryana Pragati Rally at Jagadhari. Earlier, he inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of various projects worth about Rs.334 crores.
- Apart from this, the Chief Minister also announced to make the 10-bed hospital at Sahora a 50-bed hospital, a new college building on 14 acres of land in Kishanpura village, to make Farrukhpur School a Model Sanskriti School as well as a total of Rs.680 crore for various development works in the four assembly segments of Yamunanagar district .
- Manohar Lal Khattar said that in order to promote trade, the state government plans to create an industrial cluster of 50 to 100 acres in every block so that the youth get employment opportunities.

Five clusters will be formed in all the five blocks of Yamunanagar.

- He said that industrial zones will be developed in the adjoining districts of Chandigarh, namely, Panchkula, Yamunanagar, Ambala and Kurukshetra on the lines of Gurugram.

Poster of Khelo India Youth Games, 2021 Released

Why In news

- On May 15, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar and Sports and Youth Affairs Minister Sardar Sandeep Singh released the poster of **Khelo India Youth Games, 2021** and launched the audio version of its promotional song.

Key Point

- The video version will be launched soon after the audio version of the Khelo India Youth Games Promotional Song.
- The song has been jointly composed by actors from Haryana and Bollywood and the song has been penned by the CHIEF Minister's OSD campaigners Gajendra Phogat and Naveen Lamba.
- It may be mentioned that as part of the Amrit Mahotsav of Azadi, this year, the Khelo India Youth Games, 2021 will be held in Haryana from June 4 to 13, 2022. These include 5 Indian sports in 25 under-18 games.
- The games will be held in Shahbad, Ambala, Chandigarh and Delhi besides Panchkula. Around 8,500 athletes from across the country will participate in these games.
- The Chief Minister said that in these games, cultural programmes inspired by Haryanvi culture will be organized and during the Amrit Mahotsav of Independence, the story of heroes of the freedom struggle and the introduction of outstanding sportspersons of the state will be displayed in the exhibition so that the younger generation can draw inspiration from them.
- Along with Jai and Vijay, this time the audience will also get to see Haryana's own Muscat Dhakad, which will be a symbol of Haryana's milk-curd food and sports culture.

Note:

Haryana Right to Service Commission

Why in News

- Haryana Right to Service Commission on May 16, 2022, taking action in respect of delay in issue of ration cards during the period from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 in matters relating to Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, decided to impose a fine of Rs 10,000 in the matter.

Key Points

- The Haryana Right to Service Commission was constituted by the state government vide a notification issued on July 31, 2014.
- The Commission is a statutory body constituted under Sections 12(1) and (2) of the Haryana Right to Service Act, 2014.
- The Commission will consist of 1 Chief Commissioner and a maximum of 4 Commissioners, who will oversee the effective implementation of the Haryana Right to Service Act, 2014.
- The HRTS Act, 2014, has empowered people to make the most of the services in a hassle-free, transparent and time-bound manner through an effective service delivery mechanism.

MT Kharkhauda

Why in News?

- On May 17, 2022, Chief Minister of Haryana, Manohar Lal Khattar informed that 'Maruti' is setting up its third plant in Haryana. For this, MSIL has purchased 800 acres of land at IMT Kharkhauda.

Key Points

- It is worth mentioning that 'Maruti' has continuously expanded its manufacturing facilities in Haryana by setting up another manufacturing facility in Manesar and a state-of-the-art R&D centre at Rohtak after setting up its first car plant in Gurgaon (now Gurugram) in 1983.
- IMT Kharkhauda is an integrated industrial township with world-class infrastructure at Sonapat, which is being developed over an area of about 3,217 acres.

- It is strategically located on the Delhi-Haryana border along the Western Peripheral (Kundli-Manesar-Palwal) Expressway and State Highway-18.
- It is one of the industrial model townships developed/ being developed by Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited.
- An industrial estate developed above 1500 acres of area at a particular location is defined as an industrial model township (IMT).

Third Round Table Conference Held to Develop Global City in Gurugram

Why in News?

- On May 18, 2022, a third round table conference for developing a global city was held in Gurugram under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Manohar Lal in which Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala and industry leaders and big developers from the real estate sector participated.

Key Points

- After the meeting, Chief Minister Manohar Lal told the media representatives that there is a plan to develop a global city in Gurugram which is a world-class iconic city. It will have all kinds of world class facilities.
- Instead of the pre-existing norms of urban development, the planning of this city will be done on the basis of suggestions received according to the demand of the people.
- It will include world-class planners and designers. This global city will be given a world-class look involving international level players.
- He said the Global City Mix Land Use Township will be a 'City in a City' with an inspiring workspace and a bespoke city centric living facility.
- This global city has been envisioned to tap the potential of Gurugram as a hub for the service industry.
- The project will be in the form of Central Business District (CBD) of the National Capital Region where everything necessary for working, playing, health, education, etc. will be available.

Note:

- It will be developed on more than 1,000 acres of land with office space, residential towers, hospitals, hotels, exhibitions and conference centres etc. to create a vibrant live-work-relaxed eco-system.

Darshan Lal Jain State Environment Protection Award

Why in News?

- The Department of Environment and Climate Change, Haryana has invited nominations for the Darshan Lal Jain State Environment Protection Award for the remarkable work done for environment protection on May 19, 2022.

Key Points

- Organizations/institutions, government departments, individuals, NGOs, schools, colleges and private institutions who have done exemplary work in environment protection will be eligible for these awards.
- After the nomination, two awards will be given to those selected by the Screening Committee and they will be given a citation and a prize money of Rs.3 lakh and Rs.1 lakh.
- The awards will be distributed to selected candidates at the World Environment Day celebrations on June 5, 2022.
- It may be recalled that Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar has launched a new award in the name of Shri Darshan Lal Jain, a renowned social worker from Haryana for his remarkable efforts to create awareness among the general public in various areas of environment protection and promotion, such as pollution control (water and air), conservation of natural resources, management of various types of waste and environmental issues during the Haryana Assembly session in March 2022.

Haryana-Delhi water dispute

Why in News?

- On May 20, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar, on the allegation of the Delhi government not giving its share of water, said that Haryana is

giving 1049 cusecs of its share of water to Delhi as per the Supreme Court's order and the agreements of the states.

Key Points

- The Chief Minister said that Haryana has been supplying water for Delhi's Haiderpur Water Treatment Plant, Nangloi Water Treatment Plant and Wazirabad/Chandrawal Water Treatment Plant.
- On February 29, 1996, the Supreme Court had directed the Haryana government to provide 330 cusecs of additional water per day to Delhi. Earlier, Delhi's share of water was 719 cusecs per day.
- Last year, a petition was filed by the Delhi government against Haryana alleging contempt of the Supreme Court as the Supreme Court in its judgement in 1996 had directed to always maintain a high level of water at the Wazirabad plant to meet the requirements of Delhi. Whereas, according to the Delhi Government, it is not being followed by Haryana.

Plantation in Every Village of Haryana

Why in News?

- On May 22, 2022, Haryana Forest Minister Kanwarpal informed that in order to make every village of the state green, this year, saplings will be planted on the vacant land of the panchayat by the forest department in every village of the state.

Key Points

- This was stated by Forest Minister Kanwar pal during the launch of the plantation drive at VIP Ghat of Brahasarovar by Haryana Paryavaran Society (HES) in Kurukshetra on the occasion of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.
- The forest minister said that this year the forest department's target of planting more than 1.20 crore saplings in the state will be met.
- Kanwarpal said that as much as the panchayat land in the village will be found vacant, saplings will be planted on as much land as possible. Along with this, the work of planting 10 to 100 saplings in the Shiva dhams of every village of the state will also be done.

Note:

National Worm-Free Week

Why in News?

- On May 23, 2022, the National Worm-Free Week was launched by the Health Department across the state in a series of Amrit Mahotsav of Azadi. It will be organised till May 29.

Key Points

- Under this campaign, children studying in Government schools, recognized schools, Anganwadi centres-play schools and enrolled and out of school will be fed free of cost the tablets of Albendazole to kill stomach worms.
- Under the campaign, all the children who will be deprived of taking medicines between May 23 and 26 will be given medicines from house to house from May 27 to 29.
- The Department of Health, Women and Child Development and The Department of Education will work together in coordination to make this programme a complete success.
- It is worth mentioning that at the national level, every 6 months, to improve the health of a child from one year to 19 years, a tablet of albendazole is fed by the health department to kill stomach worms, so that the child's health remains healthy.

4.69 km Long Tunnel To Emerge From Aravali Hills

Why in News?

- On May 25, 2022, Rajesh Agarwal, managing director of Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, informed that 4.69 km in the hills of The Aravalis. A long tunnel will be constructed.

Key Points

- This tunnel, built on the hills of the Aravalis, is the world's longest highway tunnel atal tunnel (9.02 km from Manali to Lahaul-Spiti Valley) will be like.
- This tunnel is 121.7 km parallel to the Kundli-Manesar-Palwal (KMP) expressway. The long Haryana Orbital Rail Corridor will be constructed.

- Haryana Railway Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited will construct the Haryana Orbital Rail Corridor.
- The corridor will be the lifeline for the newly developed industrial and residential areas from Kundli to Manesar, as well as 4.69 km from the middle of the hills. The long tunnel will be a sight to behold for Delhi-NCR.
- The Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited has claimed to have completed the tendering process for the construction of the tunnel by December in the current financial year.
- To this effect, The Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited has held consultations with the officials of 20 companies in the tunnel construction sector.
- Rajesh Agarwal, Managing Director, Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, said that after the completion of the tendering process, the construction of the Haryana Orbital Rail Corridor tunnel will be completed within a period of 30 months.
- The Aravalis are one of the oldest folded mountain ranges in the world, which is 692 km. It is long. It extends to Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and the Union Territory of Delhi.

Launch of 'AAS' : Auto Appeal Software System

Why in News?

- Recently, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched the 'AAS' auto appeal software system in the state. There are 192 services of various departments onboard under Auto Appeal Software.

Key Points

- Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal, while reviewing through video conferencing on the 'AAS' launched under the Right to Service Act, said **Haryana is the first state in the country to have launched such a unique system.**
- The decision has been taken to make the citizens aware of the time period of services provided under the Right to Service Act.

Note:



- The Chief Secretary said that the software has been introduced to revolutionize the government system by ensuring transparency and accountability in service delivery so that the functions of the citizens are within a stipulated time-frame.
- He directed all the administrative secretaries to onboard the services of their departments under the appeal software within a week.

E-Lets Education Innovation Summit under Digital Learning

Why in News?

- On May 27, 2022, Haryana Education Minister Kanwar Pal inaugurated the National Level Digital Learning e-Let's Education Innovation Summit in Panchkula district of the state.

Key Points

- In a bid to take forward Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Digital India platform, Haryana Education Minister Kanwar Pal inaugurated the summit and also discussed aspects of the importance of Information Technology in post-Covid teaching and learning.
- The Education Minister said that IT tool kits are being distributed to school children and strict steps are being taken in this direction that the children of the state do not become weaker in any sense.
- He informed that the booklet of digital learning released at the workshop is a useful document, which gives information about the education changes taking place all over the world.
- Haryana has taken the initiative to implement the New Education Policy, 2020, first in the country and somewhere this summit is also a part of it.
- The Education Minister also observed the e-Expo on Digital Learning Solution, Digital Classroom Solution, Digital Board Solution, Digital Language Lab Solution, Security and Surveillance Solution, SchoolNight, Learning for Light.
- Earlier also, on the initiative of Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar, the education department

had implemented the online teacher transfer policy, which was a revolutionary step in the education department in the era of IT .

- The 'AWSAR' app has been launched by the department. Assessment and e-report card of the students can also be obtained through this. This 'AWSAR' app was created during Covid, which has proved to be very effective.
- In the workshop, the Education Minister also felicitated West Bengal as Karma Bhoomi and The Academic Cell of Haryana Education Department and Ashish Dham for their excellent performance in e-lets.

Chief Minister Felicitates Athletes Who Won in Deaflympics, 2021

Why in News?

- On May 30, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar honoured the Deaflympics athletes with cash awards of about Rs 6 crore during the state-level felicitation ceremony held at the Tau Devi Lal Stadium in Panchkula.

Key Points

- It may be mentioned that the Deaflympics, 2021 Games were held in Brazil from May 1 to May 15, in which out of the total 16 medals won by the players of the country, 6 medals including 4 gold have been won by the players of Haryana. That is why Haryana is known as the medal factory of India.
- The Chief Minister informed that out of 65 athletes from India who participated in this international competition, 15 were from the state of Haryana.
- The Chief Minister presented cheques of Rs 1.20 crore each to Rohit Bhaker, Mahesh, Diksha Dagar and Sumit Dahiya to win gold medals in badminton, golf and wrestling respectively. At the same time, Amit and Virendra Singh, who won a bronze medal in wrestling, were given cheques of 40 lakh rupees each.

- Apart from this, the Chief Minister gave cheques of Rs 2.5 lakh each to Priyanka, Balram, Yogesh Dagar, Nirchira, Ajay Kumar, Kuldeep Sharma, Asif Khan, Aman and Shubham Vashistha to participate in this international competition.
- At the same time, the Chief Minister also dedicated four state-of-the-art sports facilities built at a cost of Rs 116 crore.
- These include the Scientific Sports Training and Rehabilitation Centre built at a cost of about Rs 50 crore, hockey astro-turf built at a cost of Rs 10 crore and renovation of athletics track at a cost of about Rs 6 crore.
- Chief Minister said, “We have made a provision to give a cash prize of Rs 6 crore to the Olympic Games gold medalist, Rs 4 crore to the silver medalist and Rs 2.5 crore to the bronze medalist.
- Haryana is the first state in the country which has made a provision to give an advance of Rs 5 lakh to the players for the preparation of the game so that they do not face any difficulty in their preparation.
- The Chief Minister said that the government has implemented the Haryana Outstanding Sportspersons (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2018 to ensure employment for outstanding sportspersons.

Integrated Multi-Modal Logistics Hub

Why in News?

- On May 24, 2022, Haryana Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal informed that the Integrated Multi-Modal Logistics Hub is being developed as the largest Integrated Logistics Hub in North India in an area of over 900 acres in Nangal Chaudhary (Mahendragarh).

Key Points

- Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal said this while addressing a review meeting through video conferencing on freight corridor projects passing through Haryana.
- He also directed to expedite the construction of a connecting line by DFCCIL to connect this integrated

multi-modal logistics hub to the Delhi-Mumbai Dedicated Freight Corridor. 246 km from Haryana. Eastern and Western Dedicated Freight Corridors of length will pass through, the construction of which will facilitate traffic on the one hand, while these corridors will also boost the economic development of Haryana. 1506 km The long Western Dedicated Freight Corridor will pass through the states of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Maharashtra and will pass through 177 km. The stretch will be built in Haryana.

- Similarly, 1875 km. The long Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor will pass through the states of Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal and will pass through 72 km. The stretch will be built in Haryana.

District Good Governance Index

Why in News?

- On May 9, 2022, Haryana Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal informed that it has been decided to prepare the District Good Governance Index for overall development in the state.

Key Points

- Through this a state level development index can be prepared by conducting comparative studies at the district level.
- This will ensure healthy competition in terms of development among the districts, which will result in an increase in the development index of the state.
- This index will be similar to the index produced by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir.
- Noteworthy, 58 development indexes on 10 sectors have been prepared by the Jammu and Kashmir government.
- These 10 sectors are – Agriculture and Allied Sectors, Commerce and Industry, Human Resource Development, Public Health, Civil Infrastructure and Facilities, Social Welfare and Development, Financial Inclusion, Justice and Public Security, Environment and Civil Central Governance.

Land will be available for 22 new sectors, four medical colleges and three women's hostels

Why In News?

- Recently, **Haryana Urban Development Authority (HSVP)** has prepared an action plan to **create 22 new sectors in 22 districts** of the state along with giving land for four medical colleges and three women's hostels along with increasing its income.

Key Points

- After the development of these new sectors, people will not have to fight for good housing and they will be able to easily get plots in posh areas.
- The government has appointed District Land Acquisition Officers in five major districts of the state- **Faridabad, Gurugram, Panchkula, Rohtak and Hisar** to solve the problems being faced in land acquisition and compensation distribution.
- About 50 acres of land will also be made available by HSVP for four medical colleges to be set up at **Panchkula, Fatehabad, Dadri and Palwal.**
- Apart from this, HSVP plans to set up women's hostels in Bhiwani, Sirsa and Rewari. Land will be made available for this also.
- For online auction of commercial and residential sites in Gurugram and Hisar, the dates of **10th and 11th May** have been fixed.
- HSVP **Chief Administrator Ajit Balaji Joshi** said that 13 online services of HSVP will be started on 22 May

to increase the income of the authority and prepare a blueprint for providing maximum facilities to the people.

- Although many HSVP services are already online, they are being increased so that people can benefit from the comfort of their homes.

Country's first pilot project started for TB test report

Why In News?

- On May 4, 2022, a pilot project for TB testing has been started in Hisar district of Haryana. This pilot project has been started for nine months.

Key Points

- Deputy CMO Dr. Anamika said that the main objective of this project, started for the first time in the country, is to quickly identify the patient.
- Now the test report of TB will not be available in 5 days, but in one day only, which will curb the infection.
- The IDDS agency has come up with this project and the US end organization is bearing the cost of the investigation.
- Earlier TB was tested, only 60 percent of the 100 people were caught. In such a situation, these people used to spread TB infection.
- IDDS Agency has tied up with Thyro Care Lab. Two organizations will conduct the survey in three and six months. After this the report will be sent to the government. If the report comes positive, then this project will be started across the country.
