Haryana Govt. approves Research Initiative in line with National Education Policy, 2020

Why in News?

According to the information given by the Directorate of Information, Public Relations and Languages of Haryana on August 30, 2023, the Haryana Government has approved the proposal to encourage research for self-reliant India in accordance with the National Education Policy 2020.

Key Points:

- The Haryana State Council of Higher Education has written to the vice-chancellors of state-funded and private universities in Haryana asking them to follow the proposed guidelines. The offer includes CM fellowships in science, technology, social sciences, humanities and problem-solving research.
- The spokesperson of the department said in this regard that its objective is to comprehensively cover 4 spectrums. The first is to find solutions to contemporary problems faced by various systems including agriculture, industry, social system, economy and technology etc.
- Second, it is important to create an authentic database for policy-making and implementation, in addition to this, it is important to find out the areas of development to create more options for livelihood. Under this, the youth of Haryana will conduct research in emerging areas of science, technology and applications of science & technology.
- The spokesperson said that efforts have been made to identify specific research topics from forty-seven consultative meetings. Funds ranging from Rs 75,000 to Rs 1,00,000 have been earmarked for each project, depending on the size and scope of the project, after recommendations from experts. Additionally, sponsoring organizations will be able to seek 25 percent contribution through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives.
- He said that to ensure transparency of the project and detailed guidelines on the format of research submission, interested parties can get information from the Council's website <https://hshec.org/>.

- This initiative reflects Haryana's commitment to promote self-reliance, innovation and holistic development in line with the educational vision of the country.

Public Health and Engineering Minister laid the foundation stone of 13.27 MLD capacity water house in Patikara

Why is News?

On September 3, 2023, Haryana's Public Health and Engineering Minister Dr. Banwari Lal laid the foundation stone of the construction work of 13.27 MLD capacity water house in village Patikara in Mahendragarh district of the state.

Key Points:

- After the construction of this water house, supply of drinking water will be ensured from 70 liters per person per day in the entire area of the city council. Rs 235.16 lakh will be spent on the water house to be built in Patikara.
- On this occasion, the Public Health and Engineering Minister instructed the officials that sewerage facility is to be linked with drinking water under 'Amrit to Yojana' to ensure sewerage system of the city and drinking water of 135 liters per person per day.
- Public Health and Engineering Minister said that drinking water supply is being increased in the state as per the instructions of Chief Minister Manohar Lal. The construction work of Rs 172.49 lakh water house is in progress at Nirpur falling in Narnaul urban area. After the completion of the work of these two water houses, drinking water of 70 liters per day per person will be made available in the remaining area of the Municipal Council.

Why is News?

On September 1, 2023, Haryana Governor Bandaru Dattatreya released the books published as four abridged versions of Valmiki Ramayana by Ramayana Prasar Parishodh Pratishthan located in Ambala district of the state.

Key Points:

- The Governor was apprised that Ramayana will be translated into 435 languages and at present 15 languages have been translated and translation work is going on in 13 languages.
- The Secretary of the Foundation informed about the plan of other research works and said that the objective of this scheme is to make constitutionally and development-based policy-based on Valmiki Ramayana, to draft evaluation.

Dr. Pawan Kumar received Lalit Kala Akademy National Award

Why is News?

Recently, Dr. Pawan Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of Fine Arts, Kurukshetra University (KU) located in Kurukshetra district of Haryana, at the National Prize Distribution Ceremony of Lalit Kala Akademi at the 63rd National Art Exhibition in Kamani Auditorium, New Delhi. (Off Hope-II) has been awarded the prestigious Lalit Kala Akademi National Award.

Key Points:

- Deputy Director of the Public Relations Department, Dr. Deepak Rai Babbar said that Lalit Kala Akademy had received 5714 entries from 2291 artists from across the country for this time's National Art Exhibition and Awards.
- Out of these entries, 20 artists were selected for awards, in which Dr. Pawan Kumar, Associate Professor,

Department of Fine Arts, Kurukshetra University, was honoured with the Lalit Kala Akademi National Award in the field of photography.

- The National Exhibition of Art (NEA) annually invites works of visual art from a variety of genres, including painting, sculpture, printmaking, photography, digital art, video art and installation. This time the works of a total of 20 artists from across the country were displayed in the exhibition.



Deputy CM launches 'Mera Bill Mera Adhikar' scheme from Gurugram

Why is News?

On September 1, 2023, as an important initiative of the Government of India, Haryana Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala launched the 'Mera Bill Mera Adhikar' scheme from Sector 15 Part-II market of Gurugram district of the state.

Key Points:

- It is worth mentioning that under an important initiative of the Government of India, with the cooperation of the State Governments, 'Mera Bill Mera Adhikar' scheme has been launched in three states of the country including Haryana, namely Assam and Gujarat & three Union Territories, namely Puducherry, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu.
- The Deputy Chief Minister said that this scheme has been launched to encourage tax payment. By being a part of this scheme, if the residents of the state pay tax to the government, then the government will also reward them in the form of incentives.

Note:

- An annual corpus fund of Rs 30 crore has been earmarked for this scheme.
- Under this scheme, a lucky draw will be conducted for consumers who upload bills on the mobile app or portal, under which two prizes of Rs 800 and Rs 10 lakh each will be given in the monthly draw.
- At the same time, two winners of the draw held on a quarterly basis will get a prize money of Rs 1 crore each.
- In this regard, Union Revenue Secretary Sanjay Malhotra said that the objective of this program is to promote the trend of customers asking for invoices/bills for all their purchases.
- Under the 'Invoice Promotion Scheme', the objective of this scheme is to bring a radical change in the behaviour of the general public, so that they start considering it their right and entitlement to 'demand bills' from all the vendors.
- All bills (B2C invoices) issued to consumers in the respective states and union territories will be eligible under this program. The minimum value of an invoice to be considered for the lucky draw has been kept at Rs 200.
- Invoices can be uploaded through mobile application 'Mera Bill Mera Adhikar' available on iOS and Android as well as web portal web.merabill.gst.gov.in.



Haryana's Science Teacher Satyapal Singh honoured with National Teacher's Award

Why In News?

On September 5, 2023, President Draupadi Murmu presented the National Teacher's Award 2023 to Satyapal Singh, a science teacher of Government Senior Secondary

School, Budauli in Rewari district of Haryana, at a function held at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi on the occasion of Teachers' Day.

Key Points:

- President Draupadi Murmu presented the National Teachers' Awards for the year 2023 to a total of 75 selected teachers from across the country at a function held at Vigyan Bhawan.
- In this teacher's honor ceremony, all the awards were given a cash prize of Rs 50,000, a citation, a shawl, a shawl and a shawl.
- Satyapal Singh, a science teacher of Government Senior Secondary School in Budauli village, is the only teacher from Haryana who has been awarded the National Teacher's Award this year. Earlier, he has also received the State Teacher's Award in the year 2021.
- Satyapal Singh, a resident of Rewari, was first posted as a science teacher in the Government High School of Tankari village in Rewari in the year 2002. At that time the school's laboratory was in a dilapidated condition. With his efforts, he made the laboratory the best laboratory and made the student proficient in science by conducting additional classes. While posting in Pranpura School, a village in Rewari, he also improved the lab there.
- Satyapal Singh has also written books for students from class 3 to 8. Jharoka EVS books for classes 3, 4 and 5 are being taught all over Haryana. At the same time, he wrote a book of science modules from sixth to eighth grade, which was beneficial for students as well as teachers.
- Apart from this, he has participated with students in 10 state level science exhibitions and national level science exhibitions. Under his guidance, 45 students have been selected for the National Resource and Merit Scholarship Test, i.e. NMMS. At the same time, 3 state-level science laboratories have been prepared by them at their own expense.
- A chocolate app for teachers and children at SCERT was developed by him. Prepared video modules for Diksha App and SCERT. Apart from this, YouTube channels and videos were created for e-learning of students during the Kovid period.
- **National Teacher's Day:**
 - Celebrated on 5th September every year since 1962, the day aims to honor the contribution of teachers including school teachers, researchers and professors in India.

Note:

- The then President of India, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, suggested celebrating his birthday as Teacher's Day in response to the students' request for the celebration.

➤ **National Teacher's Award:**

- The National Teachers Awards aims to celebrate the unique contribution of some of the finest teachers of the country and to honor those teachers who through their commitment have not only improved the quality of education but also enriched the lives of their students .
- These awards are presented by the President of India on 5th September every year.
- The award consists of a silver medal, a certificate and a cash amount of Rs 50,000.
- This year, in addition to the teachers selected by the School Education and Literacy Department, teachers selected by the Higher Education Department and Skill Development Ministry have also been included in the scope of the award.



The Chief Minister Made Several Important Announcements for the prisoners of the state.

Why In News?

On September 5, 2023, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal, while inaugurating the newly constructed extension building of the state's District Jail, Bhiwani, revealed many important announcements for the prisoners of the state.

Key Points:

- On this occasion, the Chief Minister announced a telemedicine facility for prisoners in all the jails of the state.
- Apart from this, an amount of Rs 10 crore was announced to change the diet system for prisoners, with this the diet of prisoners will be increased by Rs 10.
- The Chief Minister also approved petrol pumps outside 11 jails of the state.
- On the lines of police personnel, it was announced to provide free facilities in Haryana State Transport buses to jail personnel also.
- Apart from this, it was also announced to provide facilities for jail employees under online transfer policy in a couple cases.
- The Chief Minister said that an additional amount of Rs 1 crore will be provided to the jail inmates and the jail staff should take a pledge that if they behave well towards the prisoners, it will contribute significantly to human development.
- At present, there is enough space to keep 22 thousand criminals in jails, but the government is emphasizing on making adequate arrangements for 26 thousand criminals.
- The Chief Minister said that jail staff need training, for this a jail training center is being set up in Karnal, which will be ready in the month of December.
- Small scale industries are being established in the jails of the state. Many types of talents and talents are also hidden in the prisoners. Honorarium is given by getting them to work in jails, for this the department is studying what kind of remuneration they should get.
- Apart from this, high security facilities are being provided to the jails of the state.
- Apart from construction of jails at nine places in the state, expansion work is also being done. Apart from this, arrangements are also being made for snipers in jails to catch narcotics.
- In the jail expansion work, five barracks for male prisoners and one barrack for female prisoners have been made in the new jail premises. The capacity of a male barrack is 126 and the capacity of a female barrack is 114. Earlier the capacity of prisoners in the old jail was 561, which has now increased to 1335.

Now Jan Aushadhi Centers will open at Railway Stations, 50 stations Selected in the First Phase

Why In News?

On September 10, 2023, Naveen Kumar, Senior Commercial Manager, Ambala Division, Haryana, said that Jan Aushadhi Centers will now be opened at stations to provide affordable and accessible medicines to the common people. It also includes Rajpura railway station under Ambala division, which is located in Punjab.

key points

- After inspecting the station for Jan Aushadhi Kendra, the Commerce Department has prepared a report and sent it to the headquarters.
- Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra will be opened at Rajpura railway station under Ambala division. The

name of the only station in the division has appeared in the list released by the Railways. This facility will be available in the station premises, so that passengers and the general public can get quality generic medicines at affordable rates.

- It is noteworthy that in the first phase, 50 stations from 17 states of the country have been selected. Whereas, in the second phase, there is a plan to open Jan Aushadhi Centers at Ambala Cantt, Ambala City, Chandigarh, Saharanpur, Patiala, Bathinda and Shimla railway stations.
- Earlier also, Jan Aushadhi Centers have been opened at various places by the Central Government, where generic and quality medicines are available at cheap prices. On the same lines, now a plan has been made to open Jan Aushadhi Kendra (PMBJK) at railway stations also, so that more and more people can get its benefits.
- At present, treatment facilities at railway stations and trains are quite complex. In case of sudden ill health, first the TTE has to be informed and then after receiving the message from the control, the doctor reaches the train. Many times this delay takes a heavy toll on the patients and their caregivers. With the opening of Jan Aushadhi Center at the station, railway passengers along with the general public will get a lot of convenience.
- Under this, the design of Jan Aushadhi Center will be prepared by the National Design Institute (NID). Also, for transparency in the allocation of Jan Aushadhi centers, the process will be done online i.e. through e-tender.
- The operator will have to obtain permission from the Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices Bureau (PMBI) of the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers before operating the Jan Aushadhi Kendra.
- Under the scheme, priority will be given to individual entrepreneurs in the allotment of Jan Aushadhi Kendra.
- In the first phase, the facility of Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra will be available at 50 railway stations of the country. This includes Tirupati and Secunderabad railway stations. Now Jan Aushadhi Centers will open at Railway Stations, 50 stations Selected in the First Phase Of Andhra Pradesh, New Tinsukia, Lumding and Rangia of Assam, Darbhanga, Patna and Katihar of Bihar, Janjgir Naila, Bagbahara and Pendra Road of Chhattisgarh, Ankleshwar and Mehsana Junction of Gujarat.

- Apart from these, Sini Junction of Jharkhand, Srinagar of Jammu and Kashmir, SMVT Bangalore, Bangarpet, Mysore and Hubli Junction of Karnataka, Palakkad of Kerala, Ratlam, Mandal Mahal, Bina and Nainpur of Madhya Pradesh, Lokmanya Tilak Terminals of Maharashtra, Manmad, Pimpri, Solapur, Nagbahir and Malad, Khurda Road of Odisha, Phagwara and Rajpura of Punjab, Sawai Madhopur and Bhagat ki Kothi of Rajasthan, Tiruchirappalli, Erode and Dindigul of Tamil Nadu and Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay Junction of Uttar Pradesh.



Government will Insure the Crops of Farmers of Seven Districts

Why In News?

On September 11, 2023, Haryana Agriculture Minister JP Dalal mentioned that under the 'Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana' in the state, the crops of farmers not insured by the insurance company, will be insured by the state government. The government will soon issue guidelines regarding this.

Key Points:

- It is noteworthy that the insurance company had refused to insure the crops in seven districts of Cluster-2. Despite the premium amount being paid by the farmers, the insurance company has given up.
- The insurance company has been through huge losses. Because of many cases filed relating to claims of Cluster 2 in the court, the insurance company had withdrawn from Cluster 2.

- Haryana Government has created three clusters under 'Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana'. Each cluster includes different districts. Cluster two includes Ambala, Karnal, Sonapat, Hisar, Jind, Mahendragarh and Gurugram.
- The work of Cluster 2 was handed over to the Agriculture Insurance Company. Till July, the premium amount was deducted from the accounts of about two lakh farmers. Separate premiums have to be paid for each Kharif crop.
- Meanwhile the company refused to insure the crops. After members of the opposition parties criticized the government, the government immediately decided to insure the farmers.
- After the controversy escalated, the Agriculture Welfare Department had written a letter to the State Level Bankers Committee and issued orders to return the premium amount to the farmers. With this decision, the bank returned the amount to the farmers but the government did not take responsibility for their crops. The premium amount will not be returned to the farmers, the state government will provide insurance on this premium.



Haryana's Preeti Lamba gets Asian Games Ticket

Why In News?

On September 11, 2023, on the second and last day of the Indian Grand Prix-5 being held at the Sports Complex in Sector-7, Chandigarh, Haryana, athletes from across the country performed brilliantly and won various competitions, in which the state's runner Preeti Lamba won the Asian Qualified for the Games.

Note:

Key Points:

- Sports experts said that the performance here will greatly help the players in winning medals in the Asian Games to be held in China this month.
- It is known that more than 300 top ranking players from across the country have participated in the two-day Indian Grand Prix-5.
- **Here are the winners:**
 - **10,000 m walk race (women):** Bandana Patel of Uttar Pradesh was first with 52.53.98 minutes, Monika of Haryana was second with 57.36.87 minutes and Pinki of Haryana was third with 58.56.75 minutes.
 - **400m Hurdle Race (Women's Category):** R Vithya Ramraj of Tamil Nadu stood first with a timing of 55.43 seconds, Sinchal of Karnataka stood second with a timing of 58.46 seconds and Ramandeep Kaur of Punjab stood third with a timing of 1.01.02 seconds.
 - **3000 meter race (women's category):** Haryana's Preeti Lamba was the winner and qualified for the Asian Games. Kalaben of Gujarat stood second.
 - **Triple Jump (Women's Category):** Sharwari of Maharashtra stood first, Niharika of Punjab stood second and Kajal of Haryana stood third.
 - **Hammer Throw (Women's Category):** Tanya Chaudhary of Uttar Pradesh stood first, KM Rachna of Uttar Pradesh stood second and Fatima of Uttar Pradesh stood third.



In Case of Death Due to Collision with Animals, the Family will get Rs 5 lakh

Why In News?

On September 11, 2023, Haryana Chief Minister, Mr. Manohar Lal announced financial assistance of up to Rs. 5 lakh to the family of the victims in the case of death due to the collision of stray animals roaming on the roads in the state in a short-term extension training class program organized at Sadhna Kendra, Jhinjauli, Sonipat.

**Key Points:**

- A campaign is being run to remove these helpless animals from the roads and send them to Gaushalas and Nandishalas.
- On this occasion, the Chief Minister said that in case of death of a farmer in the field, the government provides financial assistance of Rs 5 lakh to the family and also in case of dismemberment during agricultural work.
- This year, 50 thousand solar tube well connections have been given to farmers at 75 percent subsidy. Next year their number will be increased to 70 thousand.
- It is known that Haryana is the only state in the country which buys more than a dozen crops from farmers at MSP. Farmers are being strengthened financially through Crop Insurance Scheme, Bhavantar Bharpay Yojana, Mera Pani Meri Virasat Yojana.
- The state government has increased the monthly salary of rural watchmen from Rs 6 to Rs 11 thousand. In case of sudden death, the family will be given a lump sum benefit of Rs 5 lakh and on retirement, on the lines of Anganwadi worker, a lump sum benefit of Rs 2 lakh will be given.

Why In News?

According to information received from the media on September 12, 2023, the Haryana government has appointed film actress Meeta Vashishtha as the Chairperson of the Governing Council to monitor the implementation of the Haryana Film and Entertainment Policy (HFEP).



Key Points:

- This post was vacant after the death of director and producer Satish Kaushik. He was appointed as the first Chairman by the Haryana Government.
- Meeta Vashishtha's ancestral village is Jatal village of Panipat district. He has done PG in Literature from Punjab University.
- Meeta Vashishtha has 43 years of experience in films, television serials and theater productions.
- She has served as visiting faculty in prestigious institutions like National School of Drama (NSD), National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT), National Institute of Design (NID), Whistling Woods International (WWI).
- In addition, she has also held the position of Head of the Department of Acting at the Film and Television Institute of India (FTII).
- According to Haryana Government spokesperson, apart from Meeta Vashishtha, the Council will also have an Administrative Secretary of Information, Public Relations, Language and Culture Department, Co-Chairman of the Governing Council and Director General and Member Secretary of Information, Public Relations, Language and Culture Department.
- The other members of the governing council include administrative secretary, tourism department, administrative secretary art and cultural affairs department, vice-chancellor, state university of performing and visual arts, Rohtak or their representative, media advisor to the chief minister Haryana and seven non-official members nominated by the state government.

- The Council will serve as an advisory body, providing guidance to the Executive Committee in effective implementation of the provisions of the policy.

Rohtak's Suhana Saini Becomes World Number One Ranked Player

Why in News?

In the latest world rankings released by the International Table Tennis Federation on September 12, 2023, table tennis star Suhana Saini from Rohtak district of Haryana has secured the first position in the Youth Star Contender Table Tennis World Rankings due to her excellent game.

Key Points

- Suhana Saini has achieved this feat by pairing with Bangalore's Yashasvi Ghoshade.
- Earlier, this pair had also been world ranking number one from October 22, 2022 to March 7, 2023.
- Currently Suhana has world rank 15 in Under 17 singles and world rank 28 in Under 19 singles. Whereas in India Suhana is at number one in Under 19.



Goalkeeper Shreya Hooda Selected in Asian Games Football Team

Why In News?

According to information received from the media on September 14, 2023, Shreya Hooda, resident of Sonapat district of Haryana, has been selected in the Indian women's football team for the Asian Games to be held in Hangzhou, China from September 23 to October 8.

Note:

Key Points:

- Shreya Hooda's family originally belongs to village Asan in Rohtak district of the state.
- It is known that Shreya started practicing 11 years ago. She became a part of the Indian team in the year 2022.
- It is known that Shreya Hooda started playing under football coach Anil Dhull in the year 2012.
- Apart from playing for the country in Under-14 and Under-16 teams, Shreya represented the state thrice in School Nationals and won three gold and two silver medals.
- It is noteworthy that she has also won a gold medal for the team in Khelo India Youth Games. Apart from being in the Indian team that won the AFC Women's Club Championship, she played in a goalless draw against Jordan at the Petra Stadium in Amman in March this year.
- In July 2023, he was named in the 34-member Indian squad for the AFC Olympic Qualifiers Round 2 to be played in October. Now he has been selected in the Asian Games team.
- Shreya has been selected for the post of junior trainer in the sports department this year. His appointment is in Sonipat only.

'PM E-Bus Service' will Start in 10-15 Districts of Haryana

Why In News?

According to the information received from the media on September 17, 2023, preparations have started to implement the Prime Minister e-Bus Service Project of the Government of India in 10 to 15 districts of Haryana, under which electric buses will run in the Municipal Corporation areas of the city.

Key Points:

- These electric buses will run like autos in the city, going from chowk to chowk and stopping at stoppages. This will make it easier for passengers to reach the nearest destination in the city. Passengers will get the opportunity to travel easily at low fares.

Note:

- These electric buses will be state-of-the-art. Like roadways buses, they will be 12 meters long and will have an AC facility. The cost of one bus is around Rs 2 crore. These buses will cover a distance of 200 kilometers in one charge. The company will also maintain these buses. The drivers on the buses will also be from the company.
- There will be artisans from the company in the workshop. The roadways administration will pay a charge of about Rs 62 per kilometer to the company for these buses. The operator will be from Roadways.
- Initially, Hisar district depot will get 50 electric buses. These buses will run in the city from 6 to 9 am. There will be bus service on the routes every 15 minutes.
- It is known that earlier city buses used to run in the city, which are now closed due to non-availability of permits and other reasons. In these city buses, passengers had to pay Rs 10. Now passengers have to go in auto and the fare in auto is Rs 20. Auto travel is costlier than city buses. This is the reason that now electric buses will run in their place.
- Three acres of land was earmarked for the depot workshop. A charging station for electric buses will be built at this place. Separate charging points will be made for all buses. A separate workshop will be built for the facility of repairing buses.
- It is noteworthy that 'Pradhan Mantri e-Bus Service' is implemented in many states of the country. It is also successful in some states of South India. Passengers have got a lot of convenience from electric buses. These buses will run in Karnal, Faridabad, Gurugram, Rohtak.

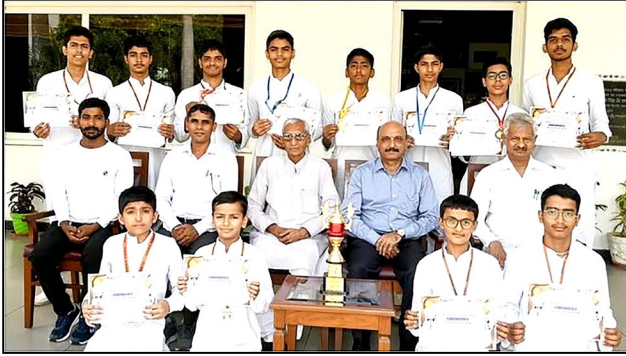
Female Surgeon Major Payal Chhabra Became the Country's First Para Commando.

'Save Trees, get Pension of Rs 2500' Scheme

Why In News?

On September 18, 2023, Gurugram's DFO (District Forest Officer) Rajiv Tejyan said that the state government is now going to give an annual pension of Rs 2500 for the maintenance and conservation of such trees of Gurugram city which are 75 years or more old.

Key Points:

- Now in the state, pensions will be available not only after employment and in old age, but also for the care and conservation of old and heritage trees. The Haryana Government has approved this pension scheme.
- This pension scheme, which will start from November, is part of the Haryana government's 'Pran Vayu Devta Yojana' and is an initiative to preserve old trees in the state.
- The age of the trees has been identified based on their circumference and other criteria set by the department, the District Forest Officer said. The pension will be paid to motivate individuals and organizations like Panchayats and Temple Trusts to ensure proper maintenance of these trees, provide nutrients and keep these trees in proper shape.

- Only healthy trees are eligible under this scheme. 40 such trees have been identified in Gurugram alone. The 40 eligible trees identified are spread across the district and include Kadamba, Indrokh, Banyan, Peepal, Neem and Jand trees.
- These trees are part of the shared heritage in Gurugram and need to be preserved. Additionally, its caretakers and plot owners will be incentivized to ensure that trees are preserved, and will inspire others to plant more such trees.
- It is known that there is a law 'Heritage Tree' in Haryana which prohibits cutting of such trees. According to the Heritage Tree Rules, 2021, if any person or organization cuts, falls or causes any damage to heritage trees, they will be liable to a fine of Rs 500 or imprisonment of 1 year or both.



Haryana Government started a Cashless Facility for Government Employees and Pensioners of the State.

Why In News?

According to information received from the media on September 19, 2023, the Haryana government has started a cashless facility for the government employees and pensioners of the state.

Key Points:

- Government employees of the state will now be able to get four major health services without taking cash in the district hospitals running in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. The state health department has issued an order to this effect.
- In the order issued to all civil surgeons, the Health Department has said that the service providers should provide cashless services to the state government employees for all the services provided under PPP mode (CT Scan, MRI, Dialysis and Cath Lab) in the district hospitals.

- In the meeting, Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala also informed that Flipkart company will build Asia's largest warehouse in Patli Hazipur of Gurugram district. This warehouse will be seven stores in 140 acres.

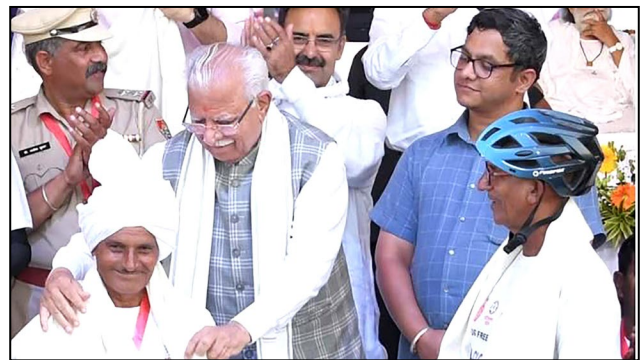
Complete Ban on Serving Hookah in Commercial Establishments in Haryana

Haryana Agricultural University Developed Another New Mustard Variety RH 1975

Why In News?

According to information received from the media on September 25, 2023, Chaudhary Charan Singh Agricultural University (HKRI) located in Hisar, Haryana has developed another improved variety of mustard, RH 1975.



Key Points:

- This variety is an excellent variety for timely sowing in irrigated areas, which will give about 12 percent more yield than the existing variety RH 749.
- It is known that Hakrivi had developed the RH 749 variety in the year 2013. Now after ten years, a better variety than this variety, RH 1975, has been developed for irrigated areas, which will prove to be very beneficial for the farmers due to higher production.
- Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. BR Kamboj told that in the 30th Annual Mustard and Mustard Workshop organized in Jammu, the Identification Committee constituted under the chairmanship of Dr. TR Sharma, Deputy Director General (Crops), Indian Council of Agricultural Research, recently sowed the RH 1975 variety on time in irrigated conditions. Has been marked for.
- The Vice Chancellor said that the RH 1975 variety, which has an average production of 11-12 quintals per acre and a production capacity of 14-15 quintals per acre, has about 39.5 percent oil content, due to which this variety will be more popular among farmers than other varieties.
- This will boost the economic condition of farmers along with an increase in oilseed production.
- RH 1975 variety has been identified for sowing in irrigated areas of Punjab, Delhi, Jammu and North Rajasthan including Haryana, so farmers of these states will get the benefit of this variety. This variety of seed will be made available to the farmers by next year.

- Prior to the above varieties, the mustard variety developed in the year 2018 is RH 725 has become the most popular among farmers at present, which is a single grown variety in about 20 to 25 percent of the area in Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh besides Haryana. This variety gives an average yield of 10-12 quintals per acre and its production capacity is also up to 14-15 quintals per acre.
- Director of Research Dr. Jeetram Sharma said that this variety has been prepared by the team of Mustard Scientists Dr. Ram Avtar, Dr. Neeraj, Dr. Manjeet and Dr. Ashok Kumar in collaboration with Dr. Rakesh Poonia, Dr. Nisha Kumari, Dr. Vinod Goyal, Dr. Mahavir and Dr. Rajbir Singh.
- It is noteworthy that last year also this team has developed two varieties of mustard RH 1424 and RH 1706. These varieties will also prove to be a milestone in increasing the productivity of mustard.
- The team has also been awarded the Best Centre Award at a workshop held in Jammu recently for its outstanding work in mustard research.
- It is known that the mustard center of Hakrivi is counted among the best research centers in the country.

Parminder Won Bronze Medal in Rowing in Asian Games

Why In News?

In the 19th Asian Games-2023 held in China on September 25, 2023, young player Parminder Singh from Shahpur village of Yamunanagar, Haryana won the bronze medal in rowing quadruple scull.

Key Points:

- Parminder Singh's team covered 2 km. Won the bronze medal by crossing the distance. Satnam Singh of Bathinda, Punjab had participated along with Parminder Singh in the double scull of rowing.
- At the same time, in quadruple scull, Parminder Singh, Satnam Singh of Mansa, Punjab, Zakir Khan of Bharatpur, Rajasthan, Sukhmeet Singh of Mansa, Punjab won the 2 km final. Won the bronze medal by covering the distance in 6:08.61 time.
