## **Important Decisions** taken in Jharkhand **Council of Ministers Meeting**

#### Why In News?

In the meeting of the Council of Ministers held in the Ministry of Jharkhand on September 1, 2022, many other important decisions were taken including approval to constitute the Jharkhand State Angulang Services (Appointment, Promotion and other conditions of service) Rules-2022.

#### **Key Points**

- In the meeting of the Cabinet, the Cabinet gave its approval to appoint the Dalpatis of Gram Raksha Dal to the post of Panchayat Secretary, relaxing the Jharkhand Panchayat Secretary (Appointment, Conditions of Service and Duties) Rules (Amendment), 2014.
- Approval was given to implement 'Rice Fortification Scheme' for distribution of fortified rice in all 24 districts of the state under targeted public distribution system under the National Food Security Act, 2013 in the state of Jharkhand.
- After the formation of Jharkhand State (Bihar Reorganization Act, 2000), Chandil Small Hydro Electric Project (District-Saraikela-Kharsawan) and Tenu Bokaro Small Hydro Electric Project (District-Bokaro) located in the geographical boundary of Jharkhand State, on the basis of As is where is PPP by Zrada Administrative approval was given to operate on the mode.
- Under the 'Chief Minister's Critical Illness Treatment Scheme', approval was given to increase the amount of medical assistance from the departmental level from Rs 5.00 lakh to Rs 10.00 lakh for the treatment of affected eligible persons and to list other incurable diseases in the list of incurable diseases already approved.
- Under the World Bank funded 'Jharkhand Power System Improvement Project', approval was given to restructure the sanctioned amount for Jharkhand Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and Jharkhand Urja Sanchar Nigam Limited.
- Approval was given for implementation of Motor Vehicles (Registration and Work of Vehicle Scraping Facility) Rules, 2021.
- In the light of the amendments made by the Central

- Government in the Central Goods and Services Tax Act. 2017, the Jharkhand Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2022 related to the proposed amendments to the Jharkhand Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 was given the second and second approval of the Council of Ministers on the introduction in the monsoon session of the Jharkhand Assembly.
- Government of India's Scheme for Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme (RDSS) F. C. Administrative approval of the revised estimated amount of Rs. 4120.29 crore after approval from the scheme and under this scheme, P. F. C., State Government and Jharkhand Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. It was approved to sign a tripartite agreement between the
- Approval has been given to amend the Recruitment Rules, 2018 for Paramedical Personnel (e.g. Nurses Grade 'A', ANM, Pharmacist, Laboratory Technician, X-Ray Technician) under Health, Medical Education and Family Welfare Department.
- Approval was given to restore the old pension scheme and extend the service period of assistant policemen.
- Approval was given to get service through external means on class IV posts under RIMS, Ranchi.

## **DPS** Ranchi Becomes National Champion in Fit India Quiz

#### Why in News?

DPS Ranchi has become the 'National Champion' in the National Round of the first edition of Fit India Quiz 2021 held recently in Mumbai. Representing the state of Jharkhand, Shakeb Arsalan and Vaishnav Garodia of DPS Ranchi emerged as the winners at the national level.

#### **Key Points**

- > The school got a cash prize of Rs 25 lakh for becoming the champion. At the same time, the participants were given a cash prize of Rs 2.5 lakh. Union Minister Anurag Thakur felicitated the winners.
- > Fit India Quiz-2021 was organized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.
- In the final round, the students of DPS Ranchi defeated teams from Tamil Nadu, Bihar and Arunachal Pradesh. Earlier in the semi-final round, the teams of Punjab, Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh were defeated.



- ➤ Launched with an aim to create awareness among students about India's rich sporting history, the Fit India Quiz saw the participation of 36,299 students in the preliminary round, where 13,500 schools across the country participated in a test conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- Selected 360 schools participated in the state round. Finalists from 36 States/UTs were identified to participate in the National Finals after a series of State Level Quarter Finals and Semi Final Rounds.

## Jharkhand's Shipra Mishra Honoured with 'National Teachers Award'

#### Why in News?

On the occasion of Teachers' Day on September 5, 2022, President Draupadi Murmu conferred the National Teacher Award-2022 to Shipra Mishra, teacher of Tata Workers Union Plus Two High School, Kadma, Jharkhand at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

#### **Key Points**

- > It is worth noting that this year 46 teachers from across the country were selected for the National Teacher Award, including Shipra Mishra, the only teacher from Jharkhand.
- Shipra Mishra was presented with a check of Rs 50,000, a silver medal and a certificate of prize money by the President.
- On this occasion a video related to the innovation made by the teacher Shipra Mishra and her contribution in the educational development of the school was also displayed in Vigyan Bhawan.
- Shipra Mishra, while teaching children in an innovative, creative way, made a difficult subject like science a subject of play for children. The complex chapters of mathematics and geometry were simplified by gardening and fencing of trees. Made the boundary wall of the garden located in the school premises from the used plastic bottle. Her different thinking, innovative idea led her to this point.
- Shipra Mishra, who sees and understands science from a different point of view, used the digital platform well. Taught children to use mobile and worked to adjust Nature and science.

- ➤ Shipra Mishra said that people use scan code, bar code, QR code only for payment, while it has wide dimensions. Shipra converted the mystery of the trees and plants in her school into a QR code. They made a QR code of detailed information of all the trees. Now any child can scan that QR code and get complete information about the tree like its secrets, properties, species, where it is found etc.
- Similarly, she made different shapes of geometry, such as triangle, quadrilateral, hexagon, circle, to make different shapes interesting in the garden. Their QR codes were also made.
- ➤ It is worth mentioning that Shipra Mishra has received many awards in the past as well. She has received Best Teacher Award from Rotary Club in the year 2017, Best Teacher Award from Inner Wheel Club, State Level Teacher Award in the year 2019 and Best Science Teachers Award by NML in 2020.

## One Lakh Wells and Ponds will be Constructed in Jharkhand

#### Why In News?

On September 12, 2022, in the meeting of the Disaster Management Authority held under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Hemant Soren, it was decided that one lakh wells and ponds would be constructed in the state to deal with the drought situation.

#### **Key Points**

- After the meeting of the Disaster Management Authority ended, Departmental Minister Banna Gupta said that a scheme of Rs 2,500 crore will be celebrated for the development and employment generation of rural areas.
- Minister Banna Gupta said that for employment generation in rural areas, work will be started on 5 schemes of MNREGA in every village, while accident insurance amount of Rs 1 lakh will be provided to the villagers.
- Apart from this, efforts will be made to ensure payment of the amount of Sarvajan Pension implemented in Jharkhand by the 5th of every month and to provide the benefit of this scheme to as many people as possible.



- The Disaster Management Minister said that 5 lakh new ration cards will be made in Jharkhand. Apart from this, the government is also focusing on ex-gratia. Necessary steps will also be taken in this direction so that the poor farmers of the state do not migrate, the cattle get adequate fodder and the shortage of water is overcome.
- ➤ In the meeting, officials informed that earlier in the years 2013-14, 2018-19 and 2022-23, drought conditions have arisen in different parts of the state. In this way, every third-fourth year, drought conditions are arising in different parts of the state and there is a problem due to the effect of the weather cycle.

## **Jharkhand Sports Policy-2022**

#### Why In News?

On September 13, 2022, Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren released the state's new sports policy 'Jharkhand Sports Policy-2022'. In this sports policy, provision has been made to prepare sports and players according to participation in national and international level by giving better training.

#### **Key Points**

The Jharkhand Sports Policy-2022 was released with the aim of ensuring that the sports and sportspersons played in the state of Jharkhand get priority, so that their talent can be identified and the talents can be prepared according to participating in the national and international level by giving better training.

#### **Highlights of Jharkhand Sports Policy-2022:**

- To make sports an integral part of their lives for all boys, girls, youth and citizens of all age groups of the state and to provide ample opportunities to participate actively in all activities.
- > To pave the way for talented players to reach national and international level in selected sports discipline.
- > To identify talent and give it a chance. To work towards their all-round development by training and making them champions going forward.

#### **Objectives of Jharkhand Sports Policy-2022:**

- Capacity building and development of sportspersons in sports in the state.
- To prepare sports as an attractive and viable career option.

- Making sports a catalyst for social change and development from panchayat level to state level.
- > To create an environment for sports and physical activities for citizens of all ages.
- To prepare a database of players and provide resources with international standards, to promote indigenous and traditional sports.
- > To promote sports tourism and also provide equal opportunities to differently abled sportspersons.

#### Other important points related to sports policy:

- Plan to work at Panchayat, Block, District and State level for talent enhancement among sportspersons.
- > Scheme to give scholarships to sportspersons.
- > Insurance facility for sportspersons.
- > Benefits of pension scheme to former players.
- > Development of high quality playgrounds in every block of the state.
- To develop day-boarding, sports school center, residential sports development center, Eklavya sports academy for the players of the state in a planned manner.
- To create the country's first sports digital database for all the players of the state.
- Establishing a Sports University.
- Reservation to sportspersons in job and educational institution.
- > Direct recruitment to the players of Jharkhand in the second, third and fourth class jobs of the state level.
- Amount of honor for players and coaches.
- Provision has also been made in the Sports Policy 2022 in relation to rural sports centre, sports academy, sports university, sports science, sports talent search, sports infrastructure development, coach development, physical fitness program, sports branding and transparency.
- Awards for best PHE, PT teacher and ground level coach, creating state talent pool for PT teacher and ground level trainers.
- To attract related PPPs and sponsors of sports activities and communication skills.
- Organizing Jharkhand Premier League for football, hockey, etc., promoting rural level sports, traditional sports.
- Enacting laws like the National Sports Development Code of India in Jharkhand to ensure a world of doping-free sports.



- > The Sports Department will work to make those organizations partners, which are interested in sports development of school children in Jharkhand.
- Special initiatives for roadmap in football, archery and athletics and state sports development fund will be created to promote sports environment in the state.

## 77 percent Reservation for SC-ST and OBC and Permanent Resident of 1932 on the basis of Khatian (Land Record)

#### Why In News?

On September 14, 2022, in the state cabinet meeting chaired by Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren, 77 percent reservation for SC, ST, Backward Classes, OBC and economically weaker section members in state government jobs and the policy of 'locality' The proposal to decide on the basis of khatiyan of 1932 was approved.

#### **Key Points**

- Cabinet Secretary Vandana Dadel told in a press conference that the Cabinet has decided to amend the Reservation of Vacancies in Government Services Act, 2001 for 77 percent reservation for SC, ST, Backward Classes, Other Backward Classes and Economically Weaker Sections. Reservation Bill has been approved.
- ➤ The Cabinet has approved the introduction of separate bills in the state assembly to decide the policy of 'locality' on the basis of the 1932 khatiyan and to reserve a total of 77 percent government jobs for various classes, including 27 percent reservation to backward classes.
- > The Cabinet also decided to get the two bills passed by the Assembly and sent to the Central government after the Governor's assent.
- Dadel said that the cabinet decided to request the central government to include both these laws in the Ninth Schedule of the Constitution, so that they cannot be challenged in any court of the country.
- The new bill to be brought to amend the policy of 'locality' will be called 'Bill 2022 to extend the definition of local persons of Jharkhand for the definition and

- identification of local resident of Jharkhand and the resultant social, cultural and other benefits to such local persons'.
- Vandana Dadel said that through this bill, the local people in the state will be defined and according to the cabinet decision, now only those who will be named in the khatiyan of 1932 in the state will be considered as local residents here. Those who do not own land or property will have to obtain proof from their gram sabha that they are residents of the state before 1932.
- ➢ In the proposed job reservation policy, there will be a provision to increase the reservation in state jobs from 10 percent to 12 percent for Scheduled Castes, from 26 percent to 28 percent for Scheduled Tribes and from 14 to 27 percent for other backward classes. It has been decided to provide 15 percent reservation for extremely backward classes and 12 percent reservation for backward classes.
- With the implementation of the government's decision, the total reservation for OBCs, Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) in the state will be 77 percent.
- The Cabinet has decided to provide 10 percent reservation for the economically weaker general category in the state through this proposed bill.

## Important Decisions of Jharkhand Council of Ministers

#### Why In News?

On September 14, 2022, along with the approval of the formation of Jharkhand Electric Vehicle Policy-2022, many other important decisions were taken in the meeting of the Council of Ministers held in the Ministry of Jharkhand.

#### **Key Points**

- Keeping in view the low rainfall and low crop cover in the state, it was approved to provide seeds to the farmers at 90% subsidy for contingency and rabi 2022-23 crops for expansion of contingency and rabi crops in the state.
- The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India approved the amended Jharkhand



- State Agricultural Produce and Livestock Marketing (Promotion and Facilitation) Bill, 2022 by adopting the draft Agricultural Produce and Livestock Marketing (Promotion and Facilitation) Act, 2017 with certain amendments as per the model Act draft.
- In order to provide fresh hot nutrition to the beneficiaries by cooking fresh hot nutrition in Anganwadi centers and mini Anganwadi centers of the state, approval was given to revise the rate of LPG combination and LPG cylinder in the scheme of supply of gas cylinders and cooking stoves under the state scheme.
- Regarding the amendment in Schedule 1 'A' of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 and the repeal of the Bihar Recreation Duty Court Fee and Section 5 of the Stamps (Revision of Surcharge) Act, 1948, the Governor's reply on the Jharkhand Finance Bill, 2021 presented earlier. After withdrawing the objection, consent was given on the Jharkhand Finance Bill, 2022.
- In the light of difficulties in the operation/ implementation of 'Mukhyamantri Pashudhan Vikas Yojana' under central plan/state plan, necessary amendment proposal was approved.
- To set up PMU (Project Management Unit) by selecting the Empanelled Agency 'Price Waterhouse Coopers Private Limited' of NICSI on the basis of nomination under Rule 245 of the Financial Rules under the Department of Higher and Technical Education for the implementation of the New Education Policy, 2020 in the state. Approval given.
- Approval was given to appoint Dr. Mary Neelima Kerketa (Retd. IAS) as the Chairman of Jharkhand Public Service Commission, Ranchi.
- Under the Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (Mid-Day Meal Scheme), it was approved to provide eggs/fruits or milk five days a week as supplementary nutrition to the children studying in schools.
- The pay revision of the state's judicial officers was approved in the light of the recommendation made by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission (SNJPC).
- ➤ The Jharkhand Reservation in Vacancies of Posts and Services Act, 2001 (as amended) was approved to amend the Bill, 2022.
- Approval was given for implementation of dress supply scheme to children of Anganwadi centers under the State Scheme to provide Winter Uniform to children of 03-06 years attending Anganwadi centers.

- MoU was approved between Azim Premji Foundation and the State Government to make available 120-150 acres of land on 99 years long-term lease for the establishment of the proposed Azim Premji University (Private University), Ranchi.
- ➤ It approved the constitution of the Bill, 2022 to extend the definition of local persons of Jharkhand and consequent social, cultural and other benefits to such local persons for the definition and identification of 'local resident of Jharkhand'.

## Digital and Azim Premji University to Open in Jharkhand

#### Why In News?

➤ On September 19, 2022, Governor Ramesh Bais approved the Kaushal Vidya Entrepreneurship, Digital and Skill Universities Bill, 2022 and the Azim Premji University Bill, 2022, passed by the Jharkhand Legislative Assembly in the monsoon session.

#### **Key Points**

- Kaushal Vidya Entrepreneurship, Digital and Skill University will be run in collaboration with the State Government and Prejha Foundation (Pan IT Alumni Rich for Jharkhand Foundation). Its headquarter will be in Khunti.
- Initially eight polytechnic institutes will be attached to this university. From here other academic courses like certificate, diploma, graduation, post-graduation etc. will run.
- As a private university, the headquarters of Azim Premji University will be in Ranchi. The state government is providing land in Itki. Professional courses like engineering, medical, management etc. will start from this university.
- The chancellor of the digital university will be the governor, while the president will be the head of the university. They will be appointed by the nodal agency for three years on the recommendation of the selection committee. The vice-chancellor will be appointed for three years on the recommendation of the selection committee by the chairman, while in other universities, the vice-chancellor is appointed by the governor-chancellor. Apart from this, vice-



- chancellor, pro-vice chancellor, registrar, chief finance and accounts officer, dean etc. will be appointed in the university.
- Azim Premji University will be the 16thprivate university in Jharkhand. In this, five percent seats will be reserved for students from economically weaker sections, while 25 percent seats will be reserved for students from Jharkhand, the university will not get any grant-in-aid or other financial assistance from the state government or the central government. VC, PROVC, Registrar, Teachers will be appointed.

#### > Objective of Digital University-

- Providing career-oriented education and skills to students wishing to enter entrepreneurship directly or startup.
- To provide life-long training opportunities to students through various courses through online education and other means.
- To create an option based credit system for competency based skills and vocational education.
- To provide practical, professional and skill based training focused teaching in line with the market and industry.

## Governor Approves Pandit Raghunath Murmu Tribal University Bill

#### Why In News?

On September 20, 2022, Governor Ramesh Bais gave assent to the Pandit Raghunath Murmu Tribal University Bill, 2022 passed by the Jharkhand Assembly.

#### **Key Points**

- The bill was sent to the Governor for the second time. Earlier, the bill was returned by the Governor due to errors in the Hindi and English version. After this, it was passed in the monsoon session of the assembly and sent again to the Governor.
- Pandit Raghunath Murmu Tribal University will be headquartered in Jamshedpur and the jurisdiction will be all over Jharkhand. The vice-chancellor of the university will be appointed by the governor on the recommendation of the search committee set by the state government.

- > The purpose of the creation of the university is to preserve, research the tribal language and the rich cultural tradition of the tribal community and encourage meritorious students of tribal society.
- The tribal university will remain open to all classes, castes and creeds. Regional centers can be opened in any district according to the need. Students will be able to get education in 10 faculties in the university.
- > The opening of this university will benefit students from Jharkhand as well as West Bengal and Odisha. The university is planned to be constructed between Galudih and Ghatshila in Jamshedpur.

## Neelima Kerketta Appointed New Chairperson of Jharkhand Public Service Commission

#### Why In News?

On September 22, 2022, Dr. Mary Neelima Kerketta, a retired Indian Administrative Service officer, has been appointed as the chairperson of the Jharkhand Public Service Commission (JPSC). After the approval of Governor Ramesh Bais, the Department of Personnel, Administrative Reforms and Official Language issued a notification appointing him as the chairman.

#### **Key Points**

- > It is worth noting that the post of JPSC President was vacant after Amitabh Choudhary completed 62 years on July 5, 2022. Due to the absence of the chairman, many appointments, interviews, promotions etc. work in the commission has come to a standstill.
- > Dr. Neelima will hold the post of President till the maximum age of 62 years from the date of assuming office. In this way, she will be able to remain in this post till August 2024.
- Dr. Neelima is a 1994 batch IAS officer of Maharashtra cadre. From 2008 to 2013, she held several posts in Jharkhand and retired as principal secretary of the health department.
- Dr. Kerketta, a resident of Karni village in Gumla district, did her matriculation from Ursuline Convent Girls High School, Ranchi, her graduation from BAU, MSc and PhD from ICAR, New Delhi. His father Dr. R. Kerketa has been the Vice Chancellor of Birsa Agricultural University.



## Ayush Hospital of 10 Beds will be Built in **Every District of Jharkhand**

#### Why In News?

On September 22, 2022, the Director of Jharkhand AYUSH Department sent a letter to all the district AYUSH officers and directed them to construct 10 bedded AYUSH hospitals in all the districts.

#### **Key Points**

- > On the lines of Allopathic system of medicine, now patients will be treated with the help of Ayurveda in the state. For this Indoor Ayurveda Hospital will be constructed.
- Hospitals of 10 beds each will be built in all 24 districts of the state. At present, 10 beds will be available in this hospital. This will facilitate treatment to patients. Ayush Hospital will be constructed on a total of 25 decimal land.
- In this regard, the Director of AYUSH Department has sent a letter to all the district AYUSH officers asking them to implement it. It has been said in the letter that in order to promote the indigenous system of medicine and to benefit the patients from the ancient system of medicine of the country, the needy patient will be admitted to AYUSH hospital and treatment will be done with AYUSH system with no side effect.
- So far there has been an outdoor facility for AYUSH therapy. After the 10 bedded AYUSH hospital is available, now the patients can be admitted to the hospital and treated with AYUSH system by providing indoor medical facilities.
- > It is worth mentioning that in view of the various diseases that are growing day by day including the Corona period, almost the whole world including Mother India has been inclined towards AYUSH, especially Naturopathy Ayurveda, in which the three wings of AYUSH medicine are Ayurvedic medicine, Homeopathic medicine and Unani system of medicine. It is said to have no side effects.

## Bindu Ahuja Wins **Star Teacher Award**

Why In News?

Bindu Ahuja, Assistant Teacher and Excellence Coordinator, Motilal Nehru Public School, Jamshedpur was honored with 'The Star Educator Awards 2022-Champion of Digital Transformation' by Learning Matters in a virtual ceremony held on September 25, 2022.

#### **Key Points**

- Bindu Ahuja has also received the Microsoft Innovator Award by Microsoft, the Out of Box Thinker Citation by Collins Publishers and the 'Educator Award' by Motilal Nehru Public School in 2022.

### Kadma Biodiversity Park

#### Why In News?

> On September 27, 2022, Tata Steel inaugurated the Kadma Biodiversity Park in Jamshedpur. This will increase the green zone around Jamshedpur.

#### **Key Points**

- ➤ The park is spread over 13.5 acres where 5650 trees and 4650 shrubs have been planted, which is in addition to the existing 300 trees. 2.3 km to the park. There are walking trails, a yoga and meditation area, bird watching areas, rainwater harvesting ponds, lily ponds, butterfly areas, and fruit and bamboo orchards.
- > There are many groups of native species of trees in the park. It also has an information center providing
- information on bird and squirrel nests, deep forested areas, grasslands and fauna and flora found in the park.
- ➤ It is noteworthy that in 2016, Tata Steel launched a Biodiversity Policy which aims at 'No Net Loss of Biodiversity', a first such commitment in the Indian Industry. In recent years, several initiatives have been taken in this direction like development of Dalma View Pond, CRM Bada Talab, Golmuri Talab, Jugsalai Muck Dump, ISWP Pond, etc.
