Sikatiya Mega **Lift Irrigation Scheme**

Why in News?

Recently, in the meeting of the Council of Ministers held under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Hemant Soren, administrative approval has been given for the estimate of Rs 484.35 crore for the **Sikatiya Mega Lift** Irrigation Scheme for providing irrigation facilities in four blocks of Deoghar and Jamtara districts.

Key Points

- In the meeting of the cabinet, administrative approval was given for providing irrigation facilities through underground pipelines in the parts of Sarath, Karo, Vidyasagar and Jamtara blocks of Deoghar and Jamtara districts.
- Under the Sikatiya Mega Lift Irrigation Scheme, cycle wise irrigation facilities will be provided in the irrigated area through a pipeline from the pump motor from Ajay Barrage Upstream located near Sikatiya village.
- > This scheme will be completed in three years, as a result of which 13,164 hectare area of 24 panchayats of the respective blocks will get a kharif irrigation facility.
- Along with this, in case the requirement of water in the fields is limited due to excessive rainfall during any period, the water can be diverted and filled to the nearby reservoirs, so that water supply through ponds to the villagers for cattle and other works. can be done.

Vidyapati Smriti Parv

Why in News?

On April 3, 2022, the main annual festival of Mithila Cultural Council 'Vidyapati Smriti Parv' concluded with pomp in Bokaro Steel City.

Key Points

- On April 2, the two-day mega event was inaugurated by garlanding the portrait of Mahakavi Vidyapati, along with lighting the lamp by Amarendu Prakash, Director-in-Charge of Bokaro Steel Plant (BSL).
- The Maithili play 'Longiya Mirchi' was staged on the second day of the program followed by a short cultural program.

- ➤ Vidyapati (1352–1448 AD) was a Maithili and Sanskrit poet, musician and writer. He is also known as 'Mathil Kavi Kokil'.
- > He has made a great effort to revive the public consciousness of the local language by giving the mantra of 'Desil Bayna Sab Jan Mittha' to the people of Mithila.

Sarhul Festival

Why in News?

> On April 4, 2022, the biggest N'ature festival of tribal society 'Sarhul' was celebrated across Jharkhand.

Key Points

- > An attractive procession was taken out from various Sarna places of the state capital, in which the procession taken out from the Sarna place at Hatma was prominent.
- In this procession, women and men of tribal society were dancing in full rhythm on the beat of mandar drum.
- It is worth mentioning that Sarhul is celebrated in Central-East India and tribal areas of Central India (mainly Jharkhand, Odisha, Bengal).
- Held on the Tritiya of Chaitra Shukla Paksha, this festival is celebrated as the marriage festival of the earth and the sun.
- This festival marks the beginning of the new year. Trees and other elements of Nature are worshiped on this festival, at this time new flowers bloom on the branches of Sal *(Shorea robusta)* trees. This day is a state holiday in Jharkhand.

Devishankar Awasthi honor to litterateur Achyutananda

Why in News?

On April 5, 2022, **Achutanand Mishra**, a litterateur of Jharkhand, was awarded the prestigious Devi Shankar Awasthi Award for the year 2021.

Key Points

> Achuthanand Mishra has been given this award for his critical book 'Kolahal Mein Kavita Ki Awaaz'.



- As a mark of respect, Mishra was given a citation, a memento and a check of Rs 11,000.
- It is worth mentioning that this award is given to a young critic for his remarkable contribution in the development of Hindi criticism.
- It was established in the year 1995 by his family including his wife Kamlesh Awasthi in the memory of famous Hindi critic Devishankar Awasthi.

MoU between State Government and TSF for skill development of youth

Why In News?

On 6th April, 2022, the State Government has signed a memorandum of understanding with Tata Steel Foundation (TSF) to set up Industrial Training Institute (ITI) at Chandil in Seraikela-Kharsawan district with the objective of skill development of more and more youth of the State and making them industry ready.

Key Points

- The MoU was signed by Saurav Roy (Chief, Corporate Social Responsibility, Tata Steel) and Satyanand Bhokta (Minister, Department of Labour, Employment, Training and Skill Development).
- The ITI to be set up at Chandil will provide training in technical and vocational courses with an initial capacity of 100 students and will start from the 2023 academic session.
- The aim is to make it a platform where local youth can take advantage of employment opportunities and fulfill their dream of contributing significantly to the income of their family.
- TSF's focus will be on reaching out to the marginalized communities, especially in the tribal areas, where the youth acquire specialized skills, right knowledge and know-how to apply them.
- > Significantly, this is the third ITI institute of Tata Steel Foundation in Jharkhand. The other two institutes are ITI Tamar and ITI Jagannathpur.

Simdega Will Soon Get International Stadium

Why in News?

Recently, the Information and Public Relations Department of the Government of Jharkhand informed that after the completion of 80 percent of the work of the stadium, sports can be organized in an international level hockey stadium soon.

Key Points

- The stadium is being constructed keeping in mind the international standards, the foundation stone of which was laid by Chief Minister Hemant Soren on October 20, 2021 at Simdega, the nursery of hockey.
- Hostels for male and female players of 50 beds are being constructed in the stadium premises. The stadium will have a seating arrangement of three thousand spectators with modern facilities.
- In its pavilion building, changing rooms for players, gym, room for doctors and coaches, and a huge podium near the stadium are also being constructed.
- It is noteworthy that on the same lines, about 70 percent construction work of the hockey stadium and sports hostel being constructed in Khunti has been completed.

Sirom Toli Sarna Sthal Beautification Plan

Why in News?

On April 7, 2022, Chief Minister Hemant Soren laid the foundation stone of Sirom Toli Sarna Sthal Beautification Plan.

Key Points

- The foundation stone for the beautification plan of Sirom Toli Sarna Sthal in the capital Ranchi is part of a series of efforts by the state government to keep the tradition and art-culture of tribal society alive, intact and preserved.
- Under this scheme, various facilities will be made available in the Sarna Sthal complex at a cost of about Rs.5 crore.
- The Chief Minister said that the State Government would make efforts to preserve all the Sarna and Masna Sthals of the State, so that the coming generations would also be well aware of its historical importance.
- Significantly, Sarna Sthal is a sacred grove in the religious traditions of the Chotanagpur plateau region in the



states of Jharkhand, Bihar, Assam and Chhattisgarh. The followers of these rituals are mainly Baiga, Kurukh, Munda and Santhal.

Tapan Patnaik

Why In News?

On April 9, 2022, Vice President M. Venkaiah Naidu presented the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award to Tapan Patnaik for his outstanding contribution in the field of Chhau dance form at the award distribution ceremony held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

Key Points

- Tapan Patnaik, director of Chhau Guru Co-State Chhau Kala Kendra, Seraikela of Seraikela Kharsawan district of Jharkhand, has presented Chhau dance at national and international level as well.
- > Tapan Patnaik has played an important role in the development of not only Seraikela but also Kharsawan and Manbhum style Chhau dance.
- Chhau Guru Tapan Patnaik has played an important role in declaring the Seraikela Chhau festival as a state festival.
- It is noteworthy that the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award is the most prestigious national award given in the field of art in India.

Vinoba Bhave University becomes first university in eastern India to launch cyber course

Why In News?

With the recent signing of MoU with Cyber Vidyapeeth Foundation by Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh, it has become the first university in eastern India to launch cyber courses.

Key Points

- > This cyber course will start from July 2022.
- > The Vice Chancellor of the university informed that the university is also planning to launch courses on artificial intelligence and data science.

According to the Cyber Vidyapeeth Foundation, an income of \$100 billion can be earned in 10 years through this course.

Jharkhand included in the State Energy and Climate Index Round-1

Why In News?

Recently, Jharkhand has been included in the category of achievers in the report related to State Energy and Climate Index Round-1 released by NITI Aayog.

Key Points

- ➤ Jharkhand ranks 18th in the State Energy and Climate Index, while the score is 35.2.
- > This index has been prepared by NITI Aayog on the basis of 2019-20 data.
- Significantly, this index tracks the efforts made by states and union territories in the climate and energy sector based on 6 parameters - performance of discoms, energy efficiency, environmental sustainability, clean energy initiatives, new initiatives and access, affordability and reliability.
- The scores of Jharkhand with respect to various parameters are as follows:
 - o performance of discoms 58.3
 - Energy Efficiency 17.2
 - o Environmental Sustainability 19
 - Clean energy initiative 2.9
 - New Initiative 9.3
 - Accessibility, Affordability and Reliability 46.5

Trikuta Mountain

Why in News?

On April 12, 2022, Chief Minister Hemant Soren held a high-level meeting regarding the Trikuta Mountain ropeway accident in Deoghar district.

Key Points

In the meeting, the Chief Minister directed the officers to constitute a high-level inquiry committee to investigate the Trikuta mountain ropeway accident and to include experts related to the ropeway in the committee constituted.



- It is worth mentioning that on April 10, a serious crisis situation arose due to the breakdown of the Trikut Parvat/Mountain ropeway, in which 59 tourists were trapped in the ropeway, so far 4 tourists have died in this incident.
- > Trikoot mountain has great religious importance for Hindus as on one side of Trikoot mountain there is a temple of Baba Vaidyanath and on the other side there is a temple of Baba Basukinath.
- This mountain has three peaks, which are known as the crown of Brahma, Vishnu and Mahesh, hence it is known as Trikuta Parvat, along with two smaller mountain peaks located here known as Ganesh and Kartik.

Canine Virus in Ranchi Zoo

Why in News?

On April 13, 2022, Director of Ranchi Zoo (Bhagwan Birsa Biological Park) Jabbar Singh informed that seven foxes have died of Canine Distemper Virus (CDV) at Birsa Zoo in Ranchi in the past one month.

Key Points

- Canine distemper virus causes severe infections of the respiratory, gastrointestinal, respiratory and central nervous systems, as well as the eyes, primarily in dogs.
- > It can also affect wild carnivores such as wolves, foxes, raccoons, red pandas, ferrets, hyenas, tigers and lions.
- > The spread and diversity of this virus in the wildlife of India has not been adequately studied.
- ➤ It is noteworthy that foxes are an endangered species protected under Schedule-II of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.

Statue of Sidhu-Kanhu to be Built in the Park and Sports Ground of Telipada, Jharkhand

Why in News?

Recently, the officials of Dhanbad Municipal Corporation said that along with the construction of a park and a sports ground in the name of martyr Sidhu-Kanhu with Rs 2 crore in Telipada, the statue of Sidhu-Kanhu will also be installed.

Key Points

- The park and sports ground are planned to be constructed at the place where people of the tribal community have been celebrating the Sohrai festival for centuries.
- > Sidhu Murmu and Kanhu Murmu were the leaders of the Santhal rebellion (1855–1856). They rebelled against the British colonial power and corrupt zamindari system in eastern India (present-day Jharkhand and Purulia and Bankura in Bengal).
- India Post also issued a postage stamp of Rs 4 in their honor in 2002. Along with this, a Sidhu-Kanhu Memorial Park has also been built in their honor in Ranchi.

Under-17 Sub-Junior National Boys-Girls Wrestling Championship and Federation Cup Senior Men-Women Wrestling

Why In News?

On April 15, 2022, Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren inaugurated the Under-17 Sub Junior National Boys-Girls Wrestling Competition and Federation Cup Senior Men-Women Wrestling Competition at Shaheed Ganpat Rai Indoor Stadium Khelgaon Ranchi.

Key Points

- On this occasion, the Chief Minister honored the wrestlers of Jharkhand, who won medals in the Under-15 National Boys and Girls Wrestling Competition held in December last year, by giving them clothes and citations.
- > These competitions are being organized under the aegis of Jharkhand State Wrestling Federation.
- The Federation Cup is being organized for the first time in Jharkhand. The Under-17 Sub Junior Boys-Girls National Wrestling Competition is being organized from April 15 to 19 at Mega Sports Complex, Hotwar, Ranchi, while the Federation Senior Wrestling Competition is being organized from April 17 to 19.



> A total of more than 1200 wrestlers are participating in the national wrestling competition. 450 wrestlers are participating in the Federation Cup Senior Wrestling competition, while 850 wrestlers from different age group categories are participating in the sub-junior wrestling competition under-17 age group.

Ninth National Race Walk Championship

Why In News?

> The Ninth National Race Walk Championship concluded on 17th April, 2022 in Ranchi city of Jharkhand.

Key Points

- Under this championship, 35 and 10 km. A walk was organized.
- 35 kms. Five athletes won medals in the event, breaking the national record. In its men's section, Haryana's Junaid, UP's Rambabu and Uttarakhand's Chandan Singh, while in women's section, Punjab's Ramandeep and Manju broke the old record.
- In the men's section, Junaid clocked 2.40.16 seconds, while in the women's section, Ramandeep clocked 3.00.04 seconds to win the gold medal.

Jehangir Gandhi Medal for Industrial Peace to Dr. Reddy

Why In News?

Recently, Paul Fernandes S.J., Director of XLRI-Xavier School of Management, Jamshedpur. It was informed that Dr. Preetha Reddy, Executive Vice President, Apollo Hospitals Enterprise Ltd. would be awarded the Sir Jehangir Gandhi Medal for Industrial and Social Peace.

Key Points

- > Dr. Reddy is widely known for his contribution to making high quality healthcare accessible to millions of people and his support to various organizations and industry bodies working for the betterment of India.
- She is the Managing Trustee of the Apollo Hospitals Educational Trust, a premier organization that drives the Apollo Group's educational efforts.

It is worth noting that the Chairman and MD of Hindustan Unilever Limited Sanjiv Mehta has been awarded this medal in 2020 and Sandeep Kataria, Global CEO of Bata Corporation, in 2021.

Committee formed to investigate Deoghar ropeway accident

Why in News?

Recently, a committee has been constituted by the Jharkhand government under the chairmanship of Principal Secretary, Finance Department Ajay Kumar Singh to investigate the Trikut Parvat ropeway accident in Deoghar, Jharkhand.

Key Points

- Apart from the chairman, three members have been included in the committee, in which Amitabh Kaushal, Secretary, Department of Tourism, will be a member nominated by the National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation along with a representative nominated by IIT-ISM Dhanbad.
- Apart from this, on behalf of the chairman of the committee, any expert from any institution of the country can be called for cooperation.
- This committee constituted under the chairmanship of Ajay Kumar Singh will give its inquiry report in two months.
- It is worth mentioning that recently 48 people were trapped in a ropeway accident at Trikoot mountain in Deoghar, Those who were saved after an operation of about 50 hours, although three people also died in it.

Why In News?

> Atharva Akshat, a class VIII student of DPS (CHAS) Bokaro won a medal in the results of International Social Studies Olympiad, 2021-22, published on April 20, 2022.

Key Points

- The Science Olympiad Foundation organizes an Olympiad every year, in which students from hundreds of schools across the country participate.
- All the activities of the Foundation have always been aimed at making learning an interesting and interactive process, in which the learner is able to truly test his/ her skills, memory, talents and knowledge.
- Apart from this the Foundation organizes the following Olympiads:

Chas Haat Initiative

Why In News?

Recently, Pakur Deputy Commissioner Varun Ranjan said that the unique initiative of Pakur district administration to establish it as a horticulture hub, 'Chas Haat Pahal', is bringing unprecedented change in the lives of women farmers.

Key Points

- Chas Haat initiative was started in the year 2021 as a joint effort of Pakur district administration and Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society.
- > The objective of this ambitious scheme is to increase the production and marketing of vegetable crops in the district with the concerted efforts and convergence of all the departments concerned. Along with this, ensuring annual income of targeted farmer families up to Rs 1 lakh under this project and promoting women entrepreneurship is also included.
- Through Chas Haat initiative, the benefits of farming schemes of different departments of the district are being given to the sisters of Sakhi Mandal in an integrated manner through Chas Haat, like-
 - To overcome the problem of irrigation, implementation of drip irrigation scheme along with providing deep boring and pump sets by the land conservation and other departments.

- Under the Didi Bari scheme by MNREGA, the scheme of 5 decimals and the arrangement of wells for irrigation facilities.
- Various types of training, capacity building and arrangement of seeds etc. through Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society, KVK and Atma.

One Station One Product Scheme

Why In News?

In order to promote local arts and products, the Institute of Agricultural Consultancy and Rural Development launched the second temporary stall of 'One Station One Product Scheme' at Ranchi station under Ranchi Railway Division of South Eastern Railway (SER) on 23rd April, 2022.

Key Points

- Under the scheme, this stall operated at Ranchi Railway Station will display and sell hand woven bags, bamboo products and woven artifacts from April 24 to May 8.
- Under the 'One Station One Product Scheme', 15 stations of Ranchi Railway Division are to be selected where stalls have been opened to promote local arts and craftsmen.
- This is the second temporary stall at Ranchi Railway Station under the 'One Station One Product Scheme'. Earlier, a 15-day temporary stall of Jharkhand Silk Textile and Handicraft Development Corporation Limited (Jharcraft) was set up.
- > Through the stalls, the passengers will be able to get information about the particular product at the railway station and will be able to buy it easily. This will increase local employment and promote the product.
- ➤ It is noteworthy that in view of the important role of Railways in promoting local products of different places, the 'One Station One Product' scheme was announced in the Union Budget 2022-23.
- This scheme was launched on March 25, 2022 at 19 stations of Indian Railways. After this it was extended to 69 more stations. After its success, this scheme is being implemented in a phased manner at 1000 railway stations across the country.



Jamshedpur's Anshuman won the award for the best writer of the year 2022

Why In News?

On April 24, 2022, Jamshedpur writer Anshuman Bhagat has been awarded the Best Writer Award for the year 2022 by the Mumbai-based organization 'Man O Mausumi'. He has been given this award for his book 'Ek Safar Mein'.

Key Points

- Anshuman has been selected as the best author for his best contribution to his book and writing style. His book 'Ek Safar Mein' is based on the behind-thescenes stories of the Bollywood TV industry and the struggles of the actors.
- Anshuman Bhagat's book 'Ek Safar Mein' was published by Authors Tree Publishing House, Chhattisgarh on December 18, 2021.
- Mann O Mausumi, a Mumbai-based organization, inspires talented writers to explore their creativity, research and organization skills and develop their writing skills.
- Man o Mousumi as a writing competition continues to create opportunities for writers from all over the world, in which writers from almost all countries of Asia participate.

Hundred smart villages will be built in the state

Why In News?

On April 25, 2022, Jharkhand Agriculture Minister Badal Patralekha told a press conference that 100 smart villages will be built in the state, which will be recommended by the MLAs and MPs.

Key Point

All these smart villages will be developed under the One Umbrella policy, where all schemes related to agriculture will be implemented, as well as a roadmap for development will be prepared by forming cooperative societies at various levels.

- The Agriculture Minister said that the smart village is being designed. Soon, the agriculture department will write to all MLAs and MPs for village selection.
- He said that a cooperative committee will be formed for milk and 50 per cent of the total cost will be provided as grant to the cooperative. The almost ready-made dairy plants at Sarath in Palamu, Sahib Ganj and Deoghar will be commissioned soon.

Virtual training camp organized for successful implementation of Birsa Harit Gram Yojana

Why In News?

On April 29, 2022, MGNREGA Commissioner Rajeshwari B. in a virtual training camp for successful implementation of Birsa Harit Gram Yojana in the financial year 2022-23 directed the trainees and officers to complete 100 per cent of the work of CPT (Anti-Animal Trench) while working in line with the target of the scheme.

Key Point

- > Speaking on the occasion, Rajeshwari B directed the officials present to motivate the farmers to plant mango, lime, guava and building plants under mixed horticulture in the financial year 2022-23 to make the people self-reliant through mixed horticulture.
- ➤ It may be recalled that on May 4, 2020, the Jharkhand government had launched three labour intensive programmes 'Birsa Harit Gram Yojana', 'Nilambar-Pitambar Jal Samriddhi Yojana' and 'Veer Shaheed Poto Ho Khel Vikas Yojana' with an aim to generate employment for workers in rural areas.
- The Birsa Green Village Scheme aims at utilizing more than two lakh acres of unused Government fallow land for afforestation.
- Under this, about five lakh families will be given 100 fruit bearing plants and the responsibility of their plantation, maintenance, land work and afforestation will be with the rural households while the ownership of the land will remain with the government.



- Under this scheme, more than five crore fruit bearing plants are expected to be planted in the next few months.
- > The scheme is estimated to have fetched an annual income of about Rs. 50,000/- from these plants after three years to each household.

State's second SRMC center opened in West Singhbhum

Why In News?

On 26 April 2022, the Labor Superintendent of West Singhbhum district launched the State's second Safe and Responsible Migration Center (SRMC) in the district for safe and responsible migration of migrant workers.

Key Points

- ➤ It is noteworthy that the first SRMC center of the state was launched in Gumla on April 20, 2022. Apart from Gumla and West Singhbhum districts, SRMI (Safe and Responsible Migration Initiative) center will soon be set up in Dumka.
- This center of West Singhbhum district will function under the supervision of the District Labor Superintendent and Employment Officer under the aegis of the District Labor and Employment Office in the form of District Level Support Cell.
- Through this, work will be done in the direction of identification of inter-state migrants and their families in West Singhbhum, so that social security of such workers can be ensured.
- Along with this, the facility of registration of workers will also be provided at the centre. It is also planned to organize camps for them from time to time.
- ➤ It is noteworthy that Chief Minister Hemant Soren had launched the Safe and Responsible Migration Initiative (SRMI) in December 2021.

Jharkhand Agriculture Loan Waiver Scheme

Why In News?

Recently, Jharkhand Agriculture Director Nisha Oraon informed that the state government is waiving loans worth Rs 3.34 crore benefiting 906 farmers per day under the 'Jharkhand Agricultural Loan Waiver Scheme'.

Key Point

- The objective of the scheme is to relieve the farmers of the State of short-term agricultural credit from the debt burden, improve the credit worthiness of the crop loan holder, ensure credit for the new crop, prevent migration of the farming community and strengthen the agricultural economy.
- Under the scheme, loans worth Rs 1,529.01 crore have been waived off to 3,83,102 farmers till March 31, 2022, of which a total of Rs 494.96 crore was disbursed to 1,22,238 people in the financial year 2020-21. In the financial year 2021-22, 2,60,864 farmers have been paid Rs 1,034.05 crore.
- The following are the required entitlements for the beneficiary of the loan waiver scheme:
 - The ryot farmers who do their own farming on their land.
 - Non-ryot farmers who do agricultural work on the land of other ryots.
 - The applicant should be a short-term crop loan holder and the crop loan should be issued from a qualified bank located in Jharkhand.
 - A farmer from the State of Jharkhand, who is above the age of 18 years and the farmer should have a valid Aadhaar number, Kisan Credit Card holder and a valid ration card holder.
 - Members holding the same crop loan from one family will be eligible. The applicant should have a standard crop loan account.
