Answer: (b)

- Explanation:
 - 'Hurricanes' in the North Atlantic and Eastern Pacific.
 - 'Typhoons' in South-East Asia and China.
 - **'Tropical Cyclones'** in the **South West Pacific** and **Indian Ocean Region**.

Hence, Option (b) is correct.

- 2. With reference to 'The India-based Neutrino Observatory', consider the following statements:
 - 1. Indian Institute of Science is the nodal institution for its implementation.
 - 2. It is located in North India due to proximity to the Equator.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

Answer: (d) Explanation:

• India-based Neutrino Observatory is being built jointly by the Department of Atomic Energy and the Department of Science and Technology.





- Its primary goal is to study the properties and interactions of weakly interacting, naturally occurring particles, called neutrinos.
- The observatory will be **located underground** so as to provide adequate **shielding to the neutrino detector from cosmic background radiation.**
- The **Tata Institute of Fundamental Research** is the nodal institution. **Hence, Statement 1 is not correct.**
- It is located in South India due to proximity to the Equator. Hence, Statement 2 is not correct.
- 3. Consider the following statements about White Dwarf Star:
 - 1. It helps understand the infant stage of a star.
 - 2. The nearest known white dwarf is Sirius B.

Select the correct answer using the code given below:

- a) 1 only

Answer: (b)

Explanation:

- A white dwarf is a star which is formed after stars such as the **Sun** exhaust their nuclear fuel (hydrogen). Hence, Statement 1 is not correct.
- The nearest known white dwarf is Sirius B. Hence, Statement 2 is correct.

Answer: (d)

Explanation:

- **INSTEX** a barter mechanism came into existence in the wake of the Trump administration's unilateral exit last year from the 2015 Iran nuclear deal.
- Belgium, Denmark, Finland, the Netherlands, Norway and Sweden have joined INSTEX. Hence, Option (d) is correct.
- 5. Operation 'Clean Art' has been launched:
- a) To promote art at primary school level under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan.
- b) To check the illegal factories that are making paint brushes with mongoose hair.
- c) To promote open defecation in villages using graffiti art.
- d) To give state patronage for artists for promoting Madhubani painting.

Explanation:

- The Uttar Pradesh Police launched **Operation Clean Art** to check the illegal factories that were making paint brushes with mongoose hair. Hence, Option (b) is correct.

Answer: (b) Explanation:

- The Sattriya dance form was introduced in the 15th century A.D by the Vaishnava saint Mahapurusha Sankaradeva in Assam for **propagation of** the **Vaishnava** faith. **Hence, Statement 1 is not correct.**
- It consists of dhemali, drum playing, known as gayan bayan, where several men play drums, in various talas and also use hand gestures.
- It is influenced by the Devadasi dance and Assamese folk dances namely Bihu, Bodos etc. Hence, Statement 2 is correct.





- 7. Which of the following is/are application(s) of Extra Neutral Alcohol?
 - 1. It is an essential ingredient of cosmetics.
 - 2. It is used in pharmaceutical products such as antiseptics, drugs, syrups, medicated sprays.

- **Extra Neutral Alcohol** is a byproduct of the sugar industry, and is formed from molasses which are residue of sugarcane processing.
- It serves as an **essential ingredient** in the manufacture of **cosmetics** and personal care products. **Hence, Statement 1 is correct.**
- It is a good solvent and is used in industries like **pharmaceutical products** such as antiseptics, drugs, syrups, medicated sprays. Hence, Statement 2 is correct.
- It is the **primary raw material** for making **alcoholic beverages. Hence, Statement 3 is correct.**

• Hornbills are found in **tropical and subtropical** Asia, Africa and Melanesia. **Hence, Statement 1 is not correct.**





- The bird is closely identified with the social and cultural life of the Nagas, as reflected in various tribal dances, songs and folklores.
- IUCN status: Vulnerable (uplisted from Near Threatened in 2018). Hence, Statement 2 is not correct.
- It is also listed in **Appendix I** of the **Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES).**
- The bird is the state bird of Kerala and Arunachal Pradesh. Hence, Statement 3 is correct.
