



Bihar Sports University Bill, 2021 | Bihar | 28 Jul 2021

Why in News

- On July 27, 2021, the Bihar Legislative Assembly unanimously passed the **Bihar Sports University Bill, 2021**.

Key Points

- The Bihar government's **Art-Culture, Sports and Youth Affairs Minister Dr. Alok Ranjan Jha** introduced this bill in the Legislative Assembly.
- The **Headquarters of the Sports University** to be established will be in **Rajgir (Nalanda)**. Apart from this, the Sports Academy being constructed in Rajgir will also come under this university.
- With the passage of this bill, **Bihar became the sixth state in the country**, where a sports university is being established.
- Before Bihar, such sports universities were **established in Gujarat, Punjab, Assam, Tamil Nadu and Rajasthan**.
- A **minimum of one-third** of the seats would be **reserved for women in this university**.

Benefits

- This will enable Bihar to develop into a **'Sporting Power' state**.
 - The players of Bihar will get a better environment and basic sports infrastructure. It is noteworthy that due to lack of basic facilities related to sports, many talented **players of Bihar used to play for other states**.
 - With proper training, players of various sports of Bihar state will get better facilities for **preparation of Olympics and other international games**.
 - The **reservation of seats** will **encourage more women** towards sports and thus, their number would increase in the field of sports.

Chief Minister Mass Marriage and Grant Scheme 2021 | Rajasthan | 28 Jul 2021

Why in News

- On July 27, 2021, the Rajasthan government started **Mukhyamantri Group Marriage and Grant Scheme 2021** to reduce wastage in marriages and **encourage mass marriages** in the state.

Key Points

- Under this, the organization, application and payment of mass marriage has been **simplified and made online**, with the aim of giving maximum benefit to the beneficiaries and the organizing institutions.
 - **About:**
 - The application (for getting permission to organize marriage) to be made at least 15 days before the date of marriage should be done **online instead of offline**.
 - Time for marriage registration increased from 15 days to 60 days.
 - The period for submission of bank account details by brides has been reduced from 15 days to 60 days.
 - An **IFMS (Integrated Financial Management System)** to be used for the transfer of Rs. 10 thousand to the bride's account on the day of marriage and later an amount of Rs. 5 thousand on production of the marriage registration certificate and other documents within a period of 60 days.
 - Dispute redressal at the **district collector level** for speedy disposal of issues.

Jharkhand Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2021 | Jharkhand | 28 Jul 2021

Why in News

- On July 27, 2021, the Jharkhand cabinet approved the **Jharkhand Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2021**, doubling the application fee, license fee and permit fee.

Key Points

- Learning license verification fee, driving license, renewal license fee has been increased.
 - Permit fees for passenger vehicles, passenger buses and motor cabs have also been increased.
 - The amount has been increased to Rs. 1500 by increasing the fee for tourist vehicles.

Supplementary Budget | Chhattisgarh | 28 Jul 2021

Why in news

- On July 27, 2021, **Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh Bhupesh Baghel** presented the first supplementary budget of the current financial year of the state in the monsoon session of the Chhattisgarh Legislative Assembly.

Key Points

- This Supplementary budget is of **2485 crore rupees**.
- In this budget, a **maximum provision of 500 crore** has been made for '**Jal Jeevan Mission Scheme**'.
- Similarly a provision of 208 crore rupees for the fight against Covid-19, 200 crore for **landless agricultural laborers (under the NYAY scheme)** and 105 crore for the interest of the loan has

been made in this budget.

- In the supplementary budget, a provision of rupees 4 crore has been made for Chhattisgarh Mahtari Dular Yojna, 1.60 crore rupees for establishment of 50 bedded MCH (Maternal-Child) in Saja and 1.30 crore rupees for establishment of Swami Vivekananda Memorial Institute in Raipur.
 - **Other provisions in the budget are:**
 - Sanchar Kranti Yojana - Rs. 100 crore
 - National Livelihood Mission - Rs. 121.90 crore
 - Majra Tola Electrification Scheme - Rs. 58 crore
 - Chief Minister Haat Bazaar Clinic Scheme - Rs. 7 crore

Key Points
