

## Madhya Pradesh in NITI Aayog Health Index 2021 | Madhya Pradesh | 28 Dec 2021

## Why in News

 On December 27, 2021, government think tank <u>NITI Aayog</u> released the fourth edition of its health index for 2019-20, ranking states on the basis of overall health performance. In this, Madhya Pradesh is ranked 17<sup>th</sup> in terms of overall health performance among large states, while Kerala is at the top.

## **Key Points**

- The report was divided into three parts large states, small states and union territories. Among the smaller states, Mizoram was the best performing state while Nagaland remained at the bottom.
- According to the NITI Aayog report, Chandigarh tops the Union Territories, followed by Dadra and Nagar Haveli at number two and Delhi at number three.
- In terms of overall health performance among large states, Madhya Pradesh ranks 17<sup>th</sup> out of 19 states with a score of 36.72. On the other hand, Kerala is ranked first with 82.20, Tamil Nadu is second with 72.42 and Telangana is third with 69.96.
- NITI Aayog's Health Index is a weighted composite score consisting of 24 indicators covering key aspects of health performance.

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
