## Why in News

 On October 12, 2021, Chhattisgarh Governor Anusuiya Uikey administered the oath to Justice Arup Kumar Goswami as the 14<sup>th</sup> Chief Justice of the Chhattisgarh High Court.

## **Key Points**

- Justice Arup Kumar Goswami was the Chief Justice of the Andhra Pradesh High Court before being transferred to the Chhattisgarh High Court.
- Justice Arup Kumar Goswami replaces outgoing Chief Justice (Acting) of Chhattisgarh High Court Justice Prashant Kumar Mishra, who has been transferred as Chief Justice of Andhra Pradesh High Court.
- It is noteworthy that under **Article 222 of the Constitution of India**, a provision has been made regarding the transfer of judges of the High Court.
- However, presently, the appointment and transfer of the judges of the High Court is being done under the <u>collegium system</u>, whose present form has evolved from the decision of the Supreme Court in the 'Second Judges Case 1993'.
