Why in News

- On September 21, 2021, **Garhwal District Magistrate Dr. Vijay Kumar Jogdande** inaugurated the hand holding support program under the **Wood Art Training Program** approved by the Government of India in **Pauri Garhwal district by lighting the lamp.**

Key Points

- On this occasion, **District Magistrate and Chief Development Officer Prashant Kumar Arya** and other dignitaries distributed certificates and kits to the participants. Simultaneously, the District Magistrate inspected the crafts and models of the temples made by handicrafts and inquired about their work.
- A total of 20 participants participated in the training program organized under the aegis of **Uttarakhand Handloom Council** and learned the nuances of handicrafts after completing the training.
- District Magistrate Dr. Jogdande said that for the first time in the district handicraft art is being displayed, which is an important effort in this area.
- He directed the concerned officers to disseminate **the ancient religious places and temples** of the district by making them out of wood and to give handicraft products as **a symbol instead of bouquets** to the dignitaries participating in the programs organized in the district.
