



Mundrupi Late Medieval Statue Found on Tosham Hill | Haryana | 11 Oct 2021

Why in News

- Recently, a **stone statue of the late medieval era** has been found on the hill located in **Tosham in Bhiwani district of Haryana**, which appears to be of a male.

Key Points

- **Earlier a stone idol of Lord Vamana was found** on Tosham hill.
- According to historical evidence, this hill was inhabited by Pandavas during their exile and Prithviraj Chauhan used to run his court here in a palace known as Baradari.
- It is noteworthy that Tosham hill is about 800 feet high. Many historical evidences exist on this hill including Ashok Chakra, Panchtirthi Kund, Gyarsiya Kund.
