

## Fortified Rice | Uttar Pradesh | 17 Sep 2021

## Why in News

 Recently, there was confusion about coarse and yellow rice found in ration shops in Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh. After this, it was clarified by the <u>Food Safety and Standards Authority of India</u> (FSSAI) that it is <u>fortified</u> rice not plastic rice.

## **Key Points**

- It is worth mentioning that for the solution of malnutrition, fortified rice is being distributed by the Central Government in the Child Development Scheme, <u>Mid-Day Meal Scheme</u> and <u>Public</u> <u>Distribution System.</u>
- Elements like vitamin **B2**, **B3** and iron have been included in this fortified rice.
- According to FSSAI, one kilogram of fortified rice is mixed with 50 kilograms of normal rice.
- There is a deficiency of nutrients like Vitamin B6, B3 and Vitamin E at the time of polishing of rice in rice meal. For this, the government has decided to distribute fortified rice.

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
