

## Sahitya Akademi Awards 2019

## Why in News

Recently, Sahitya Akademi has announced its annual Sahitya Akademi Awards 2019.

- The awardees will receive an **engraved copper-plaque**, a shawl and an amount of **Rs. 1 lakh**.
  - Indian film-maker Satyajit Ray is the designer of the plaque awarded by the Sahitya Akademi.

## Sahitya Akademi Awards

- Sahitya Akademi award established in 1954, is a literary honour that is conferred annually by Sahitya Akademi, India's National Academy of letters.
- Akademi gives 24 awards annually to literary works in the languages it has recognized and an equal number of awards to literary translations from and into the languages of India.
  - Besides the 22 languages enumerated in the Constitution of India, the Sahitya Akademi
    has recognised English and Rajasthani as languages in which its programme may be
    implemented.
- Sahitya Akademi award is the second-highest literary honour by the Government of India, after Jananpith award.
- Criteria:
  - The author must be of Indian Nationality.
  - Book/work eligible for the award must be an outstanding contribution to the language and literature to which it belongs.
  - When equal merit for books of two or more are found, certain criteria like total literary contribution and standing of authors shall be taken into consideration for declaring award.
