For the courage and clinical acuity with which she uncovers the roots, estrangements and collective restraints of personal memory.

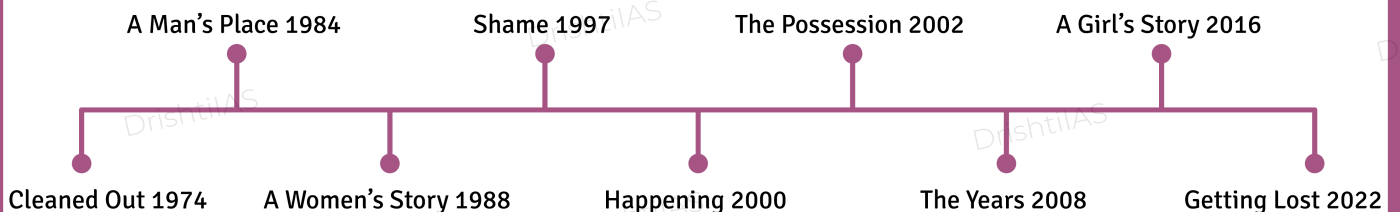
THEME OF WORK
