

## **Three Anti-Submarine Warfare Ships for Indian Navy**

The <u>Cochin Shipyard</u> unveiled the first three of eight Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) shallow water crafts commissioned for the <u>Indian Navy</u> - INS Mahe, INS Malvan, and INS Mangrol.

- These ships are poised to replace the <u>Abhay class ASW corvettes</u> and excel in anti-submarine operations, coastal defense, mine laying, and sub-surface surveillance.
- They demonstrate a **high-speed capability of 25 knots, an endurance of 1,800 nautical miles**, and are designed to undertake coordinated ASW operations with aircraft while being adept at search and rescue missions.
