 On August 25, 2022, the Ministry of Education, Government of India released the final list of names of 46 teachers from different states of the country selected for the National Teacher Awards 2022.
 It also includes the names of two teachers from Madhya Pradesh.

Key Points

- President Draupadi Murmu will present the National Awards for the year 2022 to selected teachers and teachers on the occasion of Teachers' Day on September 5, 2022 at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi. The award carries a cash prize of Rs 50,000 and a silver medal.
- Two teachers of Madhya Pradesh selected for the National Teacher Award given by the Ministry of Education, Government of India on Teacher's Day, Neeraj Saxena, teacher of Salegarh, Government Primary School of Raisen district and Om Prakash Patidar, lecturer of Government Excellence Higher Secondary School of Shajapur district. Are included.
- On the occasion of Teachers' Day, the Department of School Education and Literacy of the Ministry
 of Education organizes a national function every year on September 5, in which national awards
 are given to the best teachers of the country.
- The selection of teachers for the awards is done in a transparent manner through an online threetier selection process.
- The objective of conferring the National Award to Teachers is to underline the unique contribution of the teachers of the country and to honor such teachers, who have not only improved the quality of school education but also enriched the lives of their students with their commitment and hard work. has done.
