- Official Name International **Criminal Police Organization** (ICPO - INTERPOL)
- Establishment year 1923
- Member states 195
 - India has been a member since 1956.
- o Headquarters Lyon, France An inter-governmental organization

Objective

- Collects and disseminates information from various police forces to facilitate criminal investigation across the globe.
 - Doesn't have law enforcement powers such as arrest.

Composition

- o President (head of Interpol) elected for 4 years
- Secretary General (performs day-to-day activities) for 5 years
- o Specialized Secretariat deals with specific issues like cybercrime, terrorism, human & drug trafficking, financial & environmental crime, etc.
- o General Assembly supreme governing body (meets once a year). India hosted INTERPOL General Assembly in 2022.
