

## **Qatari Court Decision on Indian Naval Personnel**

Qatar has commuted the <u>death sentence</u> for eight Indian Navy veterans and turned that into a "varying quantum" of jail terms. The jailed former Indian Navy personnel in Qatar have been given **60 days to appeal** against the varying prison terms.

- <u>Commutation</u> of a death sentence refers to the reduction or change of a death penalty to a less severe punishment.
  - The eight Indians, whose death sentences are commuted, now qualify for repatriation to India. This falls under the 2015 Bilateral Agreement with Qatar, permitting prisoners to serve their terms in their home country.
