Why in News?

Recently, Uttar Pradesh has achieved a significant milestone by becoming the **first state in India to issue five crore Ayushman cards.**

Key Points

- The <u>Ayushman Bharat Scheme</u>, aimed at providing financial protection to economically disadvantaged individuals against healthcare costs, has seen remarkable progress in Uttar Pradesh.
 - With a total of 50,017,920 Ayushman cards issued, benefiting 74,382,304 individuals, the state has emerged as a frontrumer in implementing this crucial initiative.
- The process of issuing Ayushman cards has been streamlined, with panchayat assistants,
 Kotedars, and Asha workers conducting door-to-door visits to facilitate card creation for residents.
 - Eligible beneficiaries can also obtain their cards at the Gram Panchayat Bhawan within their respective villages.
- Under the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, Uttar Pradesh has seen a total of 3,481,252 health claims filed, with an impressive settlement rate of 92.48%.
 - This indicates the scheme's effectiveness in providing timely assistance to those in need.

Ayushman Bharat Scheme

- It is the world's largest health insurance scheme fully financed by the government.
- Launched in 2018, it offers a sum insured of tertiary care.
