Garima, a visually impaired girl of Mahendergarh district was given the <u>'Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar'</u> by **President Droupadi Murmu** in the social service category in New Delhi.

 She was honoured for her gallant initiative of "Sakshar Pathshala" in which over 1000 students were connected for education by her.
