

## Free Water Connections for BPL Families in Jamshedpur

## Why in News?

The <u>Jamshedpur Notified Area Committee (JNAC)</u> has announced a significant initiative to provide free water connections to families living <u>below the poverty line (BPL)</u> in <u>Jamshedpur</u>.

 Additionally, these families will get a 50% discount on water tariffs, making water more accessible for economically weaker households.

## **Key Points**

- Objective: This initiative aligns with the government's 'Har Ghar Swachh Jal' (Clean Water for Every Household) campaign, aiming to improve living standards and strengthen water management in the city.
- Formation of Special Team: To ensure effective implementation, JNAC has established a five-member special team comprising officials such as the Special Officer, Assistant Engineer, Junior Engineer, Revenue Officer, and City Manager. This team is tasked with identifying eligible BPL families and facilitating their enrollment in the scheme.
- Door-to-Door Identification: The special team will conduct door-to-door visits to identify and assist eligible BPL families, ensuring that the benefits reach the intended recipients.
- Alleviate the Financial Burden: This development is expected to significantly alleviate the financial burden on low-income families by providing them with essential water services at reduced costs.

Note: The Jamshedpur Notified Area Committee (JNAC) was established by the Bihar Government's notification no. 6068 on 25 June, 1924. It serves as the civic body for Jamshedpur town and is recognized as the best in Jharkhand for maintaining cleanliness.
