


Major Inter-State Water Disputes (ISWD)



- Article 262: Provides for adjudication of interstate water disputes. Under this, parliament enacted two laws: The River Boards Act, 1956 & the ISWD Act, 1956
- The River Boards Act, 1956: Establishment of river boards for the regulation of inter-state rivers
- The ISWD Act, 1956: Central government establish a temporary tribunal to resolve water disputes between two or more states [Amended in 2002; Mandated a 1 year time frame to set up the water disputes tribunal and a 3 year time frame to give a decision (Sarkaria Commission)]
- State List (Entry 17): Deals with water
- Union List (Entry 56): Parliament has the authority to regulate and develop inter-State rivers and river valleys if it's deemed necessary for the public
 interest
