Why In News?

- On December 14, 2022 Rajasthan was awarded a '**Certificate of Merit**' by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (Ministry of Power) under the '**National Energy Conservation Award 2022**' for efficient use of available resources for energy conservation and energy saving.
