

Maharana Pratap Jayanti



The **Prime Minister** paid rich tributes to the valiant warrior, **Maharana Pratap** on the occasion of his Jayanti on **9**th **May 2025**.

 Maharana Pratap, born on 9th May 1540 in Kumbhalgarh, Rajasthan, was the 13th King of Mewar and the eldest son of Udai Singh II.

Maharana Udai Singh II ruled the kingdom of Mewar with his capital at Chittor and

was also the founder of the city of Udaipur.



- The <u>Battle of Haldighati</u> (18th June 1576) was fought between <u>Maharana</u>
 Pratap and Raja <u>Man Singh</u> of <u>Amber</u>, a general of Mughal emperor <u>Akbar</u>; though Maharana Pratap fought bravely, he was <u>defeated</u> by the <u>Mughal forces</u>.
- After 1579, Maharana Pratap regained Western Mewar and set up his new capital at Chavand near Dungarpur.
- He died on 19th January 1597 and was succeeded by his son Amar Singh, who submitted to Emperor Jahangir in 1614.
