

Third President's Gallantry Medal to Ajay Sahni

Why in News?

Senior IPS officer **Ajay Kumar Sahni**, known for leading 52 encounters, has been awarded the **President's Medal for Gallantry** for the **third time** in his career.

Sahni, a 2009-batch officer from the Uttar Pradesh cadre, was honored with the President's Medal for his exceptional courage during a high-risk operation in Meerut on Republic Day (26th January 2020), praised for his gallantry, leadership, and dedication under life-threatening circumstances.

Gallantry Awards

- About: They are given to the personnel for displaying raw courage, unparalleled bravery and total disregard to personal safety in the line of duty.
 - These gallantry awards are announced twice in a year, first on the occasion of the <u>Republic Day</u> and then on the occasion of the <u>Independence Day</u>.
- Types:
 - Gallantry Awards in the Face of the Enemy:
 - Param Vir Chakra (PVC) for most conspicuous bravery
 - Mahavir Chakra (MVC) for acts of gallantry
 - Vir Chakra for acts of bravery
 - Gallantry Awards Other than in the Face of the Enemy:
 - Includes Ashoka Chakra, Kirti Chakra, and Shaurya Chakra.
- Order of precedence of the Awards:
 - Param Vir Chakra
 - Ashoka Chakra
 - Mahavir Chakra
 - Kirti Chakra
 - Vir Chakra
 - · Shaurya Chakra
