- Duration: Each paper will be 2 hours
- Level of the Examination: The papers will be of the standard expected from a graduate of a recognised university.

Note: It is **mandatory for the candidates to appear in both papers** for evaluation. A candidate will be disqualified in case he/she does not appear in both papers.
