

Uranium Mining Project in Sikar District


Why in News?

In a recent address to the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly, the Food and Civil Supplies Minister, Sumit Godara, revealed the details of a **uranium mining project** in Khandela tehsil, **Sikar district.**

Key Points

- Investment: The Uranium Corporation of India Limited (UCIL) will invest nearly Rs 3,000
 crore in the <u>uranium mining project.</u>
- **Employment:** The development is aimed at **improving local employment rates** and enhancing the socio-economic status of the area.
 - This initiative is expected to create 1,623 direct jobs, with 80 percent of these positions reserved for local residents.

 Collaboration: The project is being carried out in collaboration with the Atomic Minerals
 Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD) and the Department of Atomic Energy
 (DAE).
 - These organizations are already conducting exploratory mining in the region, with decline mining and related operations underway.
