



New Naval Base Commissioned at Gurugram | Haryana | 15 Sep 2025

Why in News?

On **12th September 2025**, the [Indian Navy](#) commissioned its new naval base, **INS Aravali**, at **Gurugram**. The commissioning was presided over by Admiral Dinesh K. Tripathi, Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS).



Key Points

 - **Maritime Ethos:** Embodies **eternal vigilance** in defending India's maritime interests.
 - Together, the crest conveys the base's commitment to **resilience, technology, and collaborative security**.
