Program Details

Revision

> Revision Tests (with 10 questions each) will be held on alternate weeks and later at the end of BMR, full length Revision tests (GS 1-4) will be provided to ensure your continuous answer writing practice and also to help you exhaustively revise the syllabus [We will not be providing fodder to these questions].

Evaluation

- > The answer written by the aspirants will be evaluated by the Drishti IAS experts if written and uploaded before 5 pm on the same day.
- > We will appreciate the peer review as it provides you an opportunity to read many answers written by your peers and evaluate your answers accordingly.

- > The questions asked in the Be Mains Ready (BMR) program are framed after a careful analysis of previous years papers and their probability of being asked by the UPSC.
